cartography

The science or practice of drawing maps.

chiaroscuro

The treatment of light and shade in drawing and painting.

| draft | Select a player for a sports team through the draft. <i>I drafted a letter of resignation.</i> |
| draftsmanship | The creation of artistic pictures or diagrams. |
| drawing | The art or activity of making drawings. <i>A series of charcoal drawings on white paper.</i> |
| exploded | (of a diagram) showing the components of a mechanism in the normal relative positions but slightly separated from each other. <i>An exploded diagram of the rifle s parts.</i> |
| flowchart | A diagram of the sequence of operations in a computer program or an accounting system. |
| formulaic | Constituting or containing a set form of words. <i>Formulaic disposable pop.</i> |
| graph | Plot or trace on a graph. |
| graphic | Of or relating to the graphic arts British Book News. <i>Graphic information such as charts and diagrams.</i> |
| intrigue | Form intrigues for in an underhand manner. <i>Within the region s borders is a wealth of interest and intrigue.</i> |
| machination | A crafty and involved plot to achieve your (usually sinister) ends. |
| maneuver | A move made to gain a tactical end. <i>He maneuvered to get the chairmanship.</i> |
| map | To establish a mapping of mathematical elements or sets. <i>A physical and genetic map of the entire human genome.</i> |
| mapping | A mathematical relation such that each element of a given set (the domain of the function) is associated with an element of another set (the range of the function). |
| plat | Make a plat of. <i>He bought back the site platted it and named it after his realtor.</i> |

- plot** Make a schematic or technical drawing of that shows interactions among variables or how something is constructed.
*He outlined his idea for a movie **plot**.*
- project** Extend out or project in space.
*He **projected** his feelings.*
- representation** The description or portrayal of someone or something in a particular way.
*A Congressional vacancy occurred in the **representation** from California.*
- schematic** In technical contexts a schematic diagram in particular of an electric or electronic circuit.
*Only a few manufacturers provide **schematics** with their gear.*
- strategically** In a way that relates to the achievement of long-term or overall aims and interests.
*Violence was deployed **strategically**.*
- summary** A brief statement or account of the main points of something.
*A **summary** formulation of a wide ranging subject.*
- synopsis** A sketchy summary of the main points of an argument or theory.
*A **synopsis** of the insurance cover provided is set out below.*
