denouement	The final resolution of the main complication of a literary or dramatic work. The film s denouement was unsatisfying and ambiguous.
design	Create the design for create or execute in an artistic or highly skilled manner. The appearance of design in the universe.
<u>diagram</u>	Schedule the operations of a locomotive or train according to a diagram. A diagram of the living room.
draft	Select a player for a sports team through the draft. I draft ed a letter of resignation.
draftsmanship	The creation of artistic pictures or diagrams.
<u>drawing</u>	The art or activity of making drawings. A series of charcoal drawing s on white paper.
exploded	(of a diagram) showing the components of a mechanism in the normal relative positions but slightly separated from each other. An exploded diagram of the rifle s parts.
flowchart	A diagram of the sequence of operations in a computer program or an accounting system.
formulaic	Constituting or containing a set form of words. <i>Formulaic</i> disposable pop.
<u>graph</u>	Plot or trace on a graph.
<u>graphic</u>	Of or relating to the graphic arts British Book News. <i>Graphic</i> information such as charts and diagrams.
intrigue	Form intrigues for in an underhand manner. Within the region s borders is a wealth of interest and intrigue .
machination	A crafty and involved plot to achieve your (usually sinister) ends.
<u>maneuver</u>	A move made to gain a tactical end. <i>He maneuvered to get the chairmanship.</i>
map	To establish a mapping of mathematical elements or sets. A physical and genetic map of the entire human genome.
<u>mapping</u>	A mathematical relation such that each element of a given set (the domain of the function) is associated with an element of another set (the range of the function.
plat	Make a plat of. He bought back the site plat ted it and named it after his realtor.



<u>plot</u>	Make a schematic or technical drawing of that shows interactions among variables or how something is constructed. <i>He outlined his idea for a movie plot.</i>
project	Extend out or project in space. <i>He projected his feelings.</i>
representation	The description or portrayal of someone or something in a particular way. A Congressional vacancy occurred in the representation from California.
<u>schematic</u>	In technical contexts a schematic diagram in particular of an electric or electronic circuit. Only a few manufacturers provide schematic s with their gear.
strategically	In a way that relates to the achievement of long-term or overall aims and interests. <i>Violence was deployed strategically</i> .
summary	A brief statement or account of the main points of something. A summary formulation of a wide ranging subject.
<u>synopsis</u>	A sketchy summary of the main points of an argument or theory. A synopsis of the insurance cover provided is set out below.
