The science or practice of drawing maps.

**chiaroscuro**

The treatment of light and shade in drawing and painting.

<b>denouement</b>	The final resolution of the main complication of a literary or dramatic work. <i>The film s <b>denouement</b> was unsatisfying and ambiguous.</i>
<b>design</b>	Create the design for create or execute in an artistic or highly skilled manner. <i>The appearance of <b>design</b> in the universe.</i>
<a href="#">diagram</a>	Schedule the operations of a locomotive or train according to a diagram. <i>A <b>diagram</b> of the living room.</i>
<b>draft</b>	Select a player for a sports team through the draft. <i>I <b>drafted</b> a letter of resignation.</i>
<b>draftsmanship</b>	The creation of artistic pictures or diagrams.
<a href="#">drawing</a>	The art or activity of making drawings. <i>A series of charcoal <b>drawings</b> on white paper.</i>
<b>exploded</b>	(of a diagram) showing the components of a mechanism in the normal relative positions but slightly separated from each other. <i>An <b>exploded</b> diagram of the rifle s parts.</i>
<b>flowchart</b>	A diagram of the sequence of operations in a computer program or an accounting system.
<b>formulaic</b>	Constituting or containing a set form of words. <i><b>Formulaic</b> disposable pop.</i>
<a href="#">graph</a>	Plot or trace on a graph.
<a href="#">graphic</a>	Of or relating to the graphic arts British Book News. <i><b>Graphic</b> information such as charts and diagrams.</i>
<b>intrigue</b>	Form intrigues for in an underhand manner. <i>Within the region s borders is a wealth of interest and <b>intrigue</b>.</i>
<b>machination</b>	A crafty and involved plot to achieve your (usually sinister) ends.
<a href="#">maneuver</a>	A move made to gain a tactical end. <i>He <b>maneuvered</b> to get the chairmanship.</i>
<b>map</b>	To establish a mapping of mathematical elements or sets. <i>A physical and genetic <b>map</b> of the entire human genome.</i>
<a href="#">mapping</a>	A mathematical relation such that each element of a given set (the domain of the function) is associated with an element of another set (the range of the function).
<b>plat</b>	Make a plat of. <i>He bought back the site <b>platted</b> it and named it after his realtor.</i>



- plot** Make a schematic or technical drawing of that shows interactions among variables or how something is constructed.  
*He outlined his idea for a movie **plot**.*
- project** Extend out or project in space.  
*He **projected** his feelings.*
- representation** The description or portrayal of someone or something in a particular way.  
*A Congressional vacancy occurred in the **representation** from California.*
- schematic** In technical contexts a schematic diagram in particular of an electric or electronic circuit.  
*Only a few manufacturers provide **schematics** with their gear.*
- strategically** In a way that relates to the achievement of long-term or overall aims and interests.  
*Violence was deployed **strategically**.*
- summary** A brief statement or account of the main points of something.  
*A **summary** formulation of a wide ranging subject.*
- synopsis** A sketchy summary of the main points of an argument or theory.  
*A **synopsis** of the insurance cover provided is set out below.*
