## Associations of "Chef" (30 Words)

<b>bake</b>	A social gathering at which baked food of a specified kind is eaten. <i>Lobster <b>bakes</b>.</i>
<b>baked</b>	Intoxicated by drink or drugs, especially cannabis. <i>Land lying <b>baked</b> in the heat.</i>
<b>bakery</b>	Baked goods such as bread and cakes. <i><b>Bakery</b> items.</i>
<b>baste</b>	Cover with liquid before cooking. <i>Slip herbs under the skin and <b>baste</b> the chicken constantly.</i>
<b>bread</b>	Coat food with breadcrumbs before cooking. <i>His day job puts <b>bread</b> on the table.</i>
<b>broil</b>	Cook under a broiler. <i>The sun <b>broils</b> the valley in the summer.</i>
<b>cafe</b>	A shop selling sweets, cigarettes, newspapers, etc. and staying open after normal hours.
<b>cake</b>	An item of soft sweet food made from a mixture of flour, fat, eggs, sugar, and other ingredients, baked and sometimes iced or decorated. <i>The blood under his nose was beginning to <b>cake</b>.</i>
<b>cook</b>	A person who prepares and cooks food especially as a job or in a specified way. <i>The band used to get up on the bandstand and really <b>cook</b>.</i>
<b>cooked</b>	Altered dishonestly; falsified. <i>As the result of <b>cooked</b> books stock prices soared.</i>
<b>cookery</b>	The act of preparing something (as food) by the application of heat. <i><b>Cookery</b> writers.</i>
<b>cooking</b>	Suitable for or used in cooking. <i>Authentic Italian <b>cooking</b>.</i>
<b>crispy</b>	Tender and brittle. <i><b>Crispy</b> fried bacon.</i>
<b>crust</b>	Form a crust or form into a crust. <i>A <b>crust</b> of snow.</i>
<b>flour</b>	Convert grain into flour. <i>Manioc <b>flour</b>.</i>
<b>fried</b>	Under the influence of alcohol or drugs. <i>Ronnie broke out a bottle of Scotch we all got pretty <b>fried</b>.</i>
<b>goody</b>	A good or favoured person, especially a hero in a book, film, etc.

<b>grill</b>	Cook over or under a grill. <i>He cooked hamburgers on the <b>grill</b>.</i>
<b>johnnycake</b>	Maize flour bread typically baked or fried on a griddle.
<b>microwave</b>	Cook food in a microwave oven. <i>He <b>microwaved</b> some steak out of the freezer.</i>
<b>oven</b>	A small furnace or kiln. <i>Bake the dish in a preheated <b>oven</b>.</i>
<b>pan</b>	An amount of something contained in a pan. <i>The critics <b>panned</b> the performance.</i>
<b>paste</b>	A paste used as an adhesive especially for sticking paper. <i>He <b>pasted</b> his opponent.</i>
<b>pastry</b>	An item of food consisting of sweet pastry with a cream jam or fruit filling. <i>Spread the mixture over the <b>pastry</b>.</i>
<b>preparation</b>	Something done to get ready for an event or undertaking. <i>A microscope <b>preparation</b>.</i>
<b><u>recipe</u></b>	A medical prescription. <i>It would be useless to enumerate all the drugs and <b>recipes</b> for their application which have been tried.</i>
<b>roast</b>	The process of roasting something especially coffee or the result of this. <i>Jessica could feel her face begin to <b>roast</b>.</i>
<b>smoked</b>	Dried and cured by hanging in wood smoke. <i>A plate of <b>smoked</b> salmon.</i>
<b>tamp</b>	A tool for tamping e.g. for tamping tobacco into a pipe bowl or a charge into a drill hole etc. <i>When the hole was <b>tamped</b> to the top gunpowder was inserted.</i>
<b>toaster</b>	A kitchen appliance (usually electric) for toasting bread.
