Associations of "Chose" (30 Words)

<u>abstention</u>	The trait of abstaining (especially from alcohol). <i>A resolution passed by 126 votes to none with six abstentions.</i>
accessory	Someone who gives assistance to the perpetrator of a crime without taking part in it. <i>Functionally the maxillae are a pair of accessory jaws.</i>
adjudicate	Bring to an end; settle conclusively. <i>The case was adjudicated in the High Court.</i>
alternative	(of one or more things) available as another possibility or choice. <i>The facts fit two alternative scenarios.</i>
alternatively	As another option or possibility. <i>Alternatively you may telephone us direct if you wish.</i>
choice	A range of possibilities from which one or more may be chosen. <i>My only choice is to refuse.</i>
<u>chosen</u>	One who is the object of choice; who is given preference. <i>He is by no means a forerunner in his chosen field.</i>
decide	Cause to decide. <i>The judge decided the case in favor of the plaintiff.</i>
decision	The ability or tendency to make decisions quickly decisiveness. <i>The burden of decision was his.</i>
determine	Find out learn or determine with certainty usually by making an inquiry or other effort. <i>The tree determines the border of the property.</i>
<u>elect</u>	Select by a vote for an office or membership. <i>They elected him leader.</i>
election	The action of electing or the fact of being elected. <i>His election to the House of Representatives.</i>

<u>elective</u>	(of a body or position) possessing or giving the power to elect. <i>Elective surgery.</i>
favour	Give unfairly preferential treatment to. <i>Slashing public spending is a policy that few politicians favour.</i>
hustings	A meeting at which candidates in an election address potential voters. <i>I was out on the hustings talking to people.</i>
incoming	Arriving at a place or position. <i>Keep an account of your incomings and outgoings.</i>
menu	(computer science) a list of options available to a computer user. <i>A no fuss dinner party menu.</i>
opt	Make a choice from a range of possibilities. <i>Consumers will opt for low priced goods.</i>
option	Buy or sell an option on. <i>His second script will have been optioned by the time you read this.</i>
<u>optional</u>	Possible but not necessary; left to personal choice. <i>A wide range of optional excursions is offered.</i>
<u>pick</u>	Hit lightly with a picking motion. <i>Pick meat from a bone.</i>
predetermine	Cause to be biased. <i>Closed questions almost predetermine the response given.</i>
sampling	(statistics) the selection of a suitable sample for study. <i>Five random samplings collected from wild cats.</i>
scarify	Make shallow incisions in (the skin), especially as a medical procedure or traditional cosmetic practice. <i>Scarify soil.</i>
select	Selected or chosen for special qualifications. <i>The opera was seen by a small and highly select audience.</i>
selected	Chosen in preference to another.
selection	A plot of land acquired by selection. <i>Such men decided the selection of candidates.</i>
<u>selective</u>	Operating at or responding to a particular frequency. <i>A new marine VHF radio with digital selective calling.</i>
selectively	By selection; in a selective manner. <i>Clothes are selectively chosen for quality.</i>
<u>vote</u>	Give or register a vote. <i>I vote that we all go home.</i>
