## Associations of "Chose" (30 Words)

<b><a href="#">abstention</a></b>	The trait of abstaining (especially from alcohol). <i>A resolution passed by 126 votes to none with six <b>abstentions</b>.</i>
<b>accessory</b>	Someone who gives assistance to the perpetrator of a crime without taking part in it. <i>Functionally the maxillae are a pair of <b>accessory</b> jaws.</i>
<b>adjudicate</b>	Bring to an end; settle conclusively. <i>The case was <b>adjudicated</b> in the High Court.</i>
<b>alternative</b>	(of one or more things) available as another possibility or choice. <i>The facts fit two <b>alternative</b> scenarios.</i>
<b>alternatively</b>	As another option or possibility. <i><b>Alternatively</b> you may telephone us direct if you wish.</i>
<b>choice</b>	A range of possibilities from which one or more may be chosen. <i>My only <b>choice</b> is to refuse.</i>
<b><a href="#">chosen</a></b>	One who is the object of choice; who is given preference. <i>He is by no means a forerunner in his <b>chosen</b> field.</i>
<b>decide</b>	Cause to decide. <i>The judge <b>decided</b> the case in favor of the plaintiff.</i>
<b>decision</b>	The ability or tendency to make decisions quickly decisiveness. <i>The burden of <b>decision</b> was his.</i>
<b>determine</b>	Find out learn or determine with certainty usually by making an inquiry or other effort. <i>The tree <b>determines</b> the border of the property.</i>
<b><a href="#">elect</a></b>	Select by a vote for an office or membership. <i>They <b>elected</b> him leader.</i>
<b>election</b>	The action of electing or the fact of being elected. <i>His <b>election</b> to the House of Representatives.</i>

<b><u>elective</u></b>	(of a body or position) possessing or giving the power to elect. <i><b>Elective</b> surgery.</i>
<b>favour</b>	Give unfairly preferential treatment to. <i>Slashing public spending is a policy that few politicians <b>favour</b>.</i>
<b>hustings</b>	A meeting at which candidates in an election address potential voters. <i>I was out on the <b>hustings</b> talking to people.</i>
<b>incoming</b>	Arriving at a place or position. <i>Keep an account of your <b>incomings</b> and outgoings.</i>
<b>menu</b>	(computer science) a list of options available to a computer user. <i>A no fuss dinner party <b>menu</b>.</i>
<b>opt</b>	Make a choice from a range of possibilities. <i>Consumers will <b>opt</b> for low priced goods.</i>
<b>option</b>	Buy or sell an option on. <i>His second script will have been <b>optioned</b> by the time you read this.</i>
<b><u>optional</u></b>	Possible but not necessary; left to personal choice. <i>A wide range of <b>optional</b> excursions is offered.</i>
<b><u>pick</u></b>	Hit lightly with a picking motion. <i><b>Pick</b> meat from a bone.</i>
<b>predetermine</b>	Cause to be biased. <i>Closed questions almost <b>predetermine</b> the response given.</i>
<b>sampling</b>	(statistics) the selection of a suitable sample for study. <i>Five random <b>samplings</b> collected from wild cats.</i>
<b>scarify</b>	Make shallow incisions in (the skin), especially as a medical procedure or traditional cosmetic practice. <i><b>Scarify</b> soil.</i>
<b>select</b>	Selected or chosen for special qualifications. <i>The opera was seen by a small and highly <b>select</b> audience.</i>
<b>selected</b>	Chosen in preference to another.
<b>selection</b>	A plot of land acquired by selection. <i>Such men decided the <b>selection</b> of candidates.</i>
<b><u>selective</u></b>	Operating at or responding to a particular frequency. <i>A new marine VHF radio with digital <b>selective</b> calling.</i>
<b>selectively</b>	By selection; in a selective manner. <i>Clothes are <b>selectively</b> chosen for quality.</i>
<b><u>vote</u></b>	Give or register a vote. <i>I <b>vote</b> that we all go home.</i>
