<b>ample</b>	More than enough in size or scope or capacity. <i>An <b>ample</b> supply of consumer goods.</i>
<b>broad in the beam</b>	Being at a peak or culminating point.
<b>chunky</b>	(of a person) short and sturdy. <i>A <b>chunky</b> soup.</i>
<b>dumpy</b>	Short and thick; as e.g. having short legs and heavy musculature. <i>The dress made her look <b>dumpy</b>.</i>
<b>embonpoint</b>	Sufficiently fat so as to have a pleasing fullness of figure.
<b>of ample proportions</b>	Affording an abundant supply.
<b>plump</b>	Having a full rounded shape. <i>The berries were <b>plump</b> and sweet.</i>
<b>portly</b>	Euphemisms for `fat. <i>A <b>portly</b> little man with a bowler hat.</i>

<b>roly-poly</b>	Short and plump.
<b>rotund</b>	(of a person) large and plump. <i>Huge stoves held great <b>rotund</b> cauldrons.</i>
<b><u>round</u></b>	(of a person's shoulders) bent forward from the line of the back. <i>She berated him in good <b>round</b> terms.</i>
<b>rounded</b>	Forming circular or elliptical shapes. <b>Rounded</b> shoulders.
<b><u>stout</u></b>	Dependable. <b>Stout</b> middle aged men.
<b>tubby</b>	Short and rather fat. <i>Historic classical recordings with a <b>tubby</b> overall sound.</i>
<b>well covered</b>	In good health especially after having suffered illness or injury.
<b>well padded</b>	In good health especially after having suffered illness or injury.
<b>well rounded</b>	In good health especially after having suffered illness or injury.
<b>well upholstered</b>	In good health especially after having suffered illness or injury.

<b>adipose</b>	(especially of body tissue) used for the storage of fat. <i><b>Adipose</b> tissue constitutes the fat of meat.</i>
<b>avaricious</b>	Having or showing an extreme greed for wealth or material gain. <i>They are <b>avaricious</b> and will do anything for money.</i>
<b>belly</b>	A pig's belly as food especially as a traded commodity. <i>His fat <b>belly</b> stuck out over his trousers.</i>
<b><u>blubber</u></b>	Excessive human fat. <i>My six pack is quickly being covered in <b>blubber</b>.</i>
<b><u>buxom</u></b>	(of a female body) healthily plump and vigorous. <i>A <b>buxom</b> blonde.</i>
<b>dietary</b>	A regulated or restricted diet. <i><b>Dietary</b> restrictions.</i>
<b>fat</b>	Make fat or plump. <i>She disliked <b>fatness</b> in herself as well as in others.</i>
<b>fatten</b>	Make or become fat or fatter. <i>Irish cattle <b>fatten</b> up quickly.</i>

<b>fatty</b>	A rotund individual. <i><b>Fatty</b> foods.</i>
<b>fleshy</b>	Resembling flesh in appearance or texture. <i><b>Fleshy</b> greeny grey leaves.</i>
<b>gobble</b>	Make a gurgling sound, characteristic of turkeys. <i>He <b>gobbled</b> up the rest of his sandwich.</i>
<b>heavy</b>	A thing such as a vehicle that is large or heavy of its kind. <i>A <b>heavy</b> discussion.</i>
<b>hypodermic</b>	A piston syringe that is fitted with a hypodermic needle for giving injections. <i><b>Hypodermic</b> needle.</i>
<b>nutritious</b>	Of or providing nourishment. <i>Home cooked burgers make a <b>nutritious</b> meal.</i>
<b>obese</b>	Grossly fat or overweight. <i>A hugely <b>obese</b> young man.</i>
<b>obesity</b>	The state of being grossly fat or overweight. <i>The problem of <b>obesity</b> among children.</i>
<b>overeat</b>	Overeat or eat immodestly make a pig of oneself. <i>If your friends <b>overeat</b> you re more likely to <b>overeat</b> too.</i>
<b>overweight</b>	Having more investment in a particular area than is normal or desirable. <i>Try not to <b>overweight</b> the boxes.</i>
<b>paunch</b>	Disembowel (an animal). <i>One of the things I had to do was to <b>paunch</b> and skin a hare.</i>
<b>paunchy</b>	Having a large belly. <i>A slightly <b>paunchy</b> balding middle aged man.</i>
<b>plump</b>	Make fat or plump. <i>She wore an outfit she d always wanted to try but felt she was too <b>plump</b> to risk.</i>
<b>portly</b>	Euphemisms for `fat. <i>Men are <b>portly</b> and women are stout.</i>
<b>pudgy</b>	(of a person or part of their body) rather fat. <i>His <b>pudgy</b> fingers.</i>
<b>reducing</b>	Any process in which electrons are added to an atom or ion as by removing oxygen or adding hydrogen always occurs accompanied by oxidation of the reducing agent. <i>A doctor supervised her <b>reducing</b>.</i>
<b>rotund</b>	(of sounds) full and rich. <i>Her brother was slim where she was <b>rotund</b>.</i>

- stout** A garment size for a large or heavy person.  
**Stout** walking boots.
- swollen** Characteristic of false pride; having an exaggerated sense of self-importance.  
Growing ever more **swollen** headed and arbitrary.
- tubby** Short and plump.  
Historic classical recordings with a **tubby** overall sound.
- weight** Blocks or discs of metal or other heavy material used in weightlifting or weight training.  
A mug half filled with coffee **weighted** down a stack of papers.
