blockhead	A stupid person; these words are used to express a low opinion of someone's intelligence.
buffoon	A person who amuses others by ridiculous behavior.
<u>clod</u>	A compact mass. <i>You re an insensitive clod and I hope you fall and break your neck.</i>
dolt	A person who is not very bright.
dullard	A slow or stupid person. <i>He was caricatured as a dupe and a dullard.</i>
dunce	A stupid person; these words are used to express a low opinion of someone's intelligence. <i>He was baffled by arithmetic and they called him a dunce at school.</i>
fall guy	The season when the leaves fall from the trees.

fool	A person who lacks good judgment. <i>He is the fool of circumstances.</i>
gull	A person who is gullible and easy to take advantage of. A foolish or stupid person.
halfwit	<i>Worst of all were the halfwits in the background guffawing at every pathetic gag.</i>
idiot	A stupid person.
ignoramus	An ignorant person. <i>Assume that your examiner is an ignoramus and explain everything to him.</i>
imbecile	A person of subnormal intelligence.
mark	A marking that consists of lines that cross each other. <i>His answer was just a punctuation mark.</i>
mug	The quantity that can be held in a mug. <i>They were no mugs where finance was concerned.</i>
nincompoop	A stupid foolish person.
patsy	A person who is easily taken advantage of, especially by being cheated or blamed for something. <i>There is a mischievous sparkle in his eyes that suggests he is no patsy.</i>
simpleton	A foolish or gullible person. <i>Stop grinning at me like a simpleton.</i>
sucker	A person especially susceptible to or fond of (a specified thing). <i>A tape recorder was attached to the phone with a rubber sucker.</i>
