#### Definitions of "City" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "city" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- A town created a city by charter and usually containing a cathedral.
- A large town.
- A municipal centre incorporated by the state or province.
- A place or situation characterized by a specified attribute.
- An incorporated administrative district established by state charter.
- The financial and commercial institutions located in the City of London.
- A large and densely populated urban area; may include several independent administrative districts.
- People living in a large densely populated municipality.





# Synonyms of "City" as a noun (4 Words)

megalopolis	A very large urban complex (usually involving several cities and towns. <i>A dizzying <b>megalopolis</b> ablaze with neon.</i>
metropolis	A very large and busy city. <i>He preferred the peaceful life of the countryside to the bustle of the</i> <i>metropolis</i> .
municipality	The governing body of a municipality. <i>Voters in each <b>municipality</b> choose between four candidates.</i>
<u>town</u>	The permanent residents of a university town. The <b>town</b> is responsible for snow removal.

# Associations of "City" (30 Words)

autonomous	Existing as an independent entity. The federation included sixteen <b>autonomous</b> republics.
borough	One of the administrative divisions of a large city.
capital	A seat of government. The drug <b>capital</b> of Columbia.
community	A body of nations or states unified by common interests. They formed a <b>community</b> of scientists.
<u>constituency</u>	A group of voters in a specified area who elect a representative to a legislative body. Most politicians are more interested in the voice of their <b>constituency</b> .
county	Relating to or characteristic of aristocratic people with an ancestral home in a particular county. <i>One of the most attractive towns in the <b>county</b>.</i>
depopulate	Substantially reduce the population of (an area. The disease could <b>depopulate</b> a town the size of Bournemouth.



<u>district</u>	Divide into areas. A <b>district</b> health authority.
<u>domestic</u>	Converted or adapted to domestic use. They are often called to sort out a <b>domestic</b> .
downtown	The downtown area of a town or city. <b>Downtown</b> Chicago.
enfranchise	Free (a slave). Slaves were <b>enfranchise</b> d in the mid 19th century.
<u>local</u>	A local branch of an organization especially a trade union. Catch the <b>local</b> into New Delhi.
locality	An area or neighbourhood. A working class <b>locality</b> .
metropolitan	Relating to or denoting a metropolitan or his see. <i>Metropolitan</i> Spain.
municipal	Of or relating to the government of a municipality. <i>Municipal offices.</i>
municipality	The governing body of a municipality. Voters in each <b>municipality</b> choose between four candidates.
<u>neighborhood</u>	An area within a city or town that has some distinctive features (especially one forming a community. <i>An ethnic <b>neighborhood</b>.</i>
populous	Having a large population; densely populated. The <b>populous</b> city of Shanghai.
prefecture	The official residence or headquarters of a prefect. Enraged fans besieged the <b>Prefecture</b> of Police.
<u>province</u>	The territory occupied by one of the constituent administrative districts of a nation. <i>It was his province to take care of himself.</i>
<u>provincial</u>	An inhabitant of a province of a country or empire. Deeply <b>provincial</b> and conformist.
quarter	A quarter of a hundredweight 25 pounds. Unemployment fell during the last <b>quarter</b> .
<u>slum</u>	A district of a city marked by poverty and inferior living conditions. <i>He moved from a two room <b>slum</b> into a local authority house.</i>
sophisticate	Make someone or something more sophisticated. She ll <b>sophisticate</b> in three languages.



subdivide	Divide (something that has already been divided or that is a separate unit. <i>The heading was <b>subdivide</b>d into eight separate sections.</i>
suburban	Of or characteristic of a suburb. Elizabeth despised Ann s house proudness as deeply <b>suburban</b> .
<u>town</u>	The chief city or town of a region. Britain s major <b>town</b> s and cities.
urban	Denoting or relating to popular dance music associated with black performers. <i>The <b>urban</b> population.</i>
<u>village</u>	A self contained district or community within a town or city regarded as having features characteristic of village life. <i>The village of Claxby.</i>
ward	Admit to or care for in a hospital ward. They put her in a 4 bed <b>ward</b> .
