I **clapboard** We **clapboard**
You **clapboard** You **clapboard**
He/She/It **clapboards** They **clapboard**

Clapboard in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I **am clapboarding** We **are clapboarding**
You **are clapboarding** You **are clapboarding**
He/She/It **is clapboarding** They **are clapboarding**

Clapboard in Present Perfect Tense

I **have clapboarded** We **have clapboarded**
You **have clapboarded** You **have clapboarded**
He/She/It **has clapboarded** They **have clapboarded**
