<u>brevity</u>	The use of brief expressions. The brevity of human life.

<u>concise</u>	Giving a lot of information clearly and in a few words; brief but comprehensive. A concise explanation.
conciseness	Terseness and economy in writing and speaking achieved by expressing a great deal in just a few words.
directness	The quality of being honest and straightforward in attitude and speech. <i>He was renowned for the clarity and directness of his sermons.</i>
drawl	A slow speech pattern with prolonged vowels. Suits me fine he drawl ed.
<u>ease</u>	Of share prices interest rates etc decrease in value or amount. She gave up smoking with ease .
easiness	Freedom from difficulty or hardship or effort. The easiness we feel when sleeping.



forthrightness	The quality of being honest and straightforward in attitude and speech.
frank	A member of the ancient Germanic peoples who spread from the Rhine into the Roman Empire in the 4th century. <i>Frank ulceration.</i>
generality	An idea or conclusion having general application. His service was better than that offered by the generality of doctors.
<u>honesty</u>	A European plant with purple or white flowers and round, flat, translucent seed pods which are used for indoor flower arrangements. I bought potatoes and tomatoes from the roadside stall putting 3 in the honesty box.
laconic	Brief and to the point; effectively cut short. <i>The laconic reply yes.</i>
mortality	The quality or state of being mortal. The causes of mortality among infants and young children.
pithiness	Terseness and economy in writing and speaking achieved by expressing a great deal in just a few words.
<u>pithy</u>	Concise and full of meaning. Welcomed her pithy comments.
simple	A medicinal herb, or a medicine made from one. <i>Simple mechanisms</i> .
simplicity	A lack of penetration or subtlety. For the sake of simplicity this chapter will concentrate upon one theory.
<u>sincerity</u>	The absence of pretence, deceit, or hypocrisy. They demanded some proof of my sincerity .
straightness	Having honest intentions.
succinctness	Terseness and economy in writing and speaking achieved by expressing a great deal in just a few words.
<u>terse</u>	Brief and to the point; effectively cut short. Short and terse and easy to understand.
transience	An impermanence that suggests the inevitability of ending or dying. The transience of life and happiness.
<u>transient</u>	(physics) a short-lived oscillation in a system caused by a sudden change of voltage or current or load. A transient cold spell.
well	Often used as a combining form in a good or proper or satisfactory manner or to a high standard good is a nonstandard dialectal variant for well. <i>The currents</i> well up.
