Present Tense	<b>class / classes</b>
Past Tense	<b>classed</b>
Present Participle	<b>classing</b>
Past Participle	<b>classed</b>

## Conjugate Class

### Class in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

<b>I class</b>	<b>We class</b>
<b>You class</b>	<b>You class</b>
<b>He/She/It classes</b>	<b>They class</b>

## **Class in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

<b>I am classing</b>	<b>We are classing</b>
<b>You are classing</b>	<b>You are classing</b>
<b>He/She/It is classing</b>	<b>They are classing</b>

## **Class in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

<b>I have classed</b>	<b>We have classed</b>
<b>You have classed</b>	<b>You have classed</b>
<b>He/She/It has classed</b>	<b>They have classed</b>

## **Class in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

<b>I have been classing</b>	<b>We have been classing</b>
<b>You have been classing</b>	<b>You have been classing</b>
<b>He/She/It has been classing</b>	<b>They have been classing</b>

## **Class in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

<b>I classed</b>	<b>We classed</b>
<b>You classed</b>	<b>You classed</b>
<b>He/She/It classed</b>	<b>They classed</b>

## **Class in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I was classing</b>	<b>We were classing</b>
<b>You were classing</b>	<b>You were classing</b>
<b>He/She/It was classing</b>	<b>They were classing</b>

**Class in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had classed</b>	<b>We had classed</b>
<b>You had classed</b>	<b>You had classed</b>
<b>He/She/It had classed</b>	<b>They had classed</b>

**Class in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>I had been classing</b>	<b>We had been classing</b>
<b>You had been classing</b>	<b>You had been classing</b>
<b>He/She/It had been classing</b>	<b>They had been classing</b>

<b>I will class</b>	<b>We will class</b>
<b>You will class</b>	<b>You will class</b>
<b>He/She/It will class</b>	<b>They will class</b>

<b>I will be classing</b>	<b>We will be classing</b>
<b>You will be classing</b>	<b>You will be classing</b>
<b>He/She/It will be classing</b>	<b>They will be classing</b>

**I will have classed**

**We will have classed**

**You will have classed**

**You will have classed**

**He/She/It will have classed**

**They will have classed**

**I will have been classing**

**We will have been classing**

**You will have been classing**

**You will have been classing**

**He/She/It will have been classing**

**They will have been classing**
