Classicise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I classicise We classicise
You classicise You classicise
He/She/It classicises They classicise

Classicise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am classicising We are classicising
You are classicising You are classicising
He/She/It is classicising They are classicising

Classicise in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have classicised We have classicised You have classicised He/She/It has classicised They have classicised

Classicise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been classicising
You have been classicising
He/She/It has been classicising
They have been classicising

Classicise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I classicised We classicised
You classicised You classicised
He/She/It classicised They classicised

Classicise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was classicising We were classicising
You were classicising You were classicising
He/She/It was classicising They were classicising

Classicise in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had classicised We had classicised You had classicised He/She/It had classicised They had classicised

Classicise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been classicising
You had been classicising
He/She/It had been classicising
They had been classicising

Classicise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will classicise
You will classicise
He/She/It will classicise
They will classicise

Classicise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be classicising
You will be classicising
He/She/It will be classicising
They will be classicising

Classicise in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have classicised We will have classicised You will have classicised He/She/It will have classicised They will have classicised

Classicise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been classicising
You will have been classicising
He/She/It will have been classicising
They will have been classicising
