**assort**

(of genes or characteristics) become distributed among cells or progeny.  
*He would **assort** it with the fabulous dogs as a monstrous invention.*

**bracket**

Enclose a complex expression in brackets to denote that the whole of the expression rather than just a part of it has a particular relation such as multiplication or division to another expression.

*It s always best to **bracket** your exposures.*

Place in a particular class or group.

<b>exhibit</b>	Give an exhibition of to an interested audience. <i>No foreign painters were <b>exhibited</b>.</i>
<b><u>file</u></b>	File a formal charge against. <i>Criminal charges were <b>filed</b> against the firm.</i>
<b>grade</b>	Arrange in or allocate to grades classify or sort. <i>The sky <b>graded</b> from blue at the top of the shot to white on the horizon.</i>
<b>group</b>	Put in a group or groups. <i>Can you <b>group</b> these shapes together.</i>
<b><u>index</u></b>	List in an index. <i>The pins are retracted and <b>indexed</b> to occupy an adjacent slotted position.</i>
<b>lay out</b>	Impose as a duty, burden, or punishment.
<b>list</b>	Include or enter in a list. <i>I have <b>listed</b> four reasons below.</i>
<b>order</b>	Bring order to or into. <i>He <b>ordered</b> that the ship be abandoned.</i>
<b><u>organize</u></b>	Arrange systematically; order. <i>She was unsuited to anything where she had to <b>organize</b> herself.</i>
<b>position</b>	Put into a certain place or abstract location. <i>A development plan which will <b>position</b> the city as a major economic force in the region.</i>
<b>present</b>	Present somebody with something usually to accuse or criticize. <i>The commencement speaker <b>presented</b> a forceful speech that impressed the students.</i>
<b>put in order</b>	Make an investment.
<b>put into sets</b>	Make an investment.
<b>put out</b>	Cause to be in a certain state; cause to be in a certain relation.
<b>range</b>	Have a range be capable of projecting over a certain distance as of a gun. <i>The instruments <b>ranged</b> from tuba to cymbals.</i>

<b>set out</b>	Disappear beyond the horizon.
<b>sort</b>	Resolve the problems or difficulties of. <i>The problem with the engine was soon <b>sorted</b>.</i>
<b>sort out</b>	Arrange or order by classes or categories.
<b>spread out</b>	Spread out or open from a closed or folded state.
<b>stratify</b>	Of seeds be germinated by stratifying. <i><b>Stratifying</b> patients into well defined risk groups.</i>

<b>demote</b>	Assign to a lower position; reduce in rank. <i>The head of the army was <b>demoted</b> to deputy defence secretary.</i>
<b>distinguish</b>	Be a distinctive feature, attribute, or trait; sometimes in a very positive sense. <i>We <b>distinguish</b> several kinds of maple.</i>
<b>encode</b>	(of a gene) be responsible for producing (a substance or behaviour). <i><b>Encode</b> pictures digitally.</i>
<b>equal</b>	A person who is of equal standing with another in a group. <i>On <b>equal</b> terms.</i>
<b>exile</b>	Expel from a country. <i>The poet was <b>exiled</b> because he signed a letter protesting the government's actions.</i>
<b>group</b>	Arrange into a group or groups. <i>A methyl <b>group</b>.</i>

<b>identify</b>	Identify as in botany or biology for example. <i>A system that ensures that the pupil's real needs are identified.</i>
<b>newly</b>	Only just; recently. <i>A <b>newly</b> arranged hairdo.</i>
<b>organize</b>	Form (a number of people) into a trade union or other political group. <i>Julie <b>organized</b> food and drink for the band.</i>
<b>pigeonhole</b>	Put a document in a pigeonhole. <i>He <b>pigeonholed</b> his charts and notes.</i>
<b>rank</b>	Give someone or something a rank or place within a grading system. <i>He was fined and reduced to the <b>ranks</b>.</i>
<b>recognized</b>	Provided with a secure reputation. <i>A <b>recognized</b> authority.</i>
<b>relegate</b>	Assign to a class or kind. <i>United were <b>relegated</b> to division two.</i>
<b>reorganize</b>	Organize anew, as after a setback. <i>We have to <b>reorganize</b> the entire workload.</i>
<b>separate</b>	Separated according to race sex class or religion. <i>The two pieces that we had glued <b>separated</b>.</i>
<b>sort</b>	A person of a specified nature. <i>The problem with the engine was soon <b>sorted</b>.</i>
<b>stereotype</b>	View or represent as a stereotype. <i>I was <b>stereotyped</b> as a lazy Southern European.</i>
