Definitions of "Classless" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “classless” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Favoring social equality.*
- *(of a society) not divided into social classes.*
- *Not showing obvious signs of belonging to a particular social class.*

Synonyms of "Classless" as an adjective (6 Words)

egalitarian	Believing in or based on the principle that all people are equal and deserve equal rights and opportunities. <i>A fairer more egalitarian society.</i>
elected	Subject to popular election.
parliamentary	In accord with rules and customs of a legislative or deliberative assembly. <i>Parliamentary government.</i>
popular	Representing or appealing to or adapted for the benefit of the people at large. <i>Editorials accusing the government of wanting to gag the popular press.</i>

populist Appealing to or aimed at ordinary people.
*It seems their efforts in creating a **populist** movement for chamber music are paying off.*

representative Being or characteristic of government by representation in which citizens exercise power through elected officers and representatives.
*There was no **representative** body to fight for cricketers until 1968.*

Usage Examples of "Classless" as an adjective

- *His voice was classless.*
- *A classless society.*
- *This is of course a classless society.*
