- Favoring social equality.
- (of a society) not divided into social classes.
- Not showing obvious signs of belonging to a particular social class.

Synonyms of "Classless" as an adjective (6 Words)

<u>egalitarian</u>	Believing in or based on the principle that all people are equal and deserve equal rights and opportunities. <i>A fairer more egalitarian society.</i>
elected	Subject to popular election.
parliamentary	In accord with rules and customs of a legislative or deliberative assembly. <i>Parliamentary government</i> .
popular	Representing or appealing to or adapted for the benefit of the people at large. Editorials accusing the government of wanting to gag the popular press.



populistAppealing to or aimed at ordinary people.
It seems their efforts in creating a **populist** movement for chamber music
are paying off.
Being or characteristic of government by representation in which citizens

representative exercise power through elected officers and representatives. *There was no representative body to fight for cricketers until 1968.*
