### **Definitions of "Classroom" as a noun**

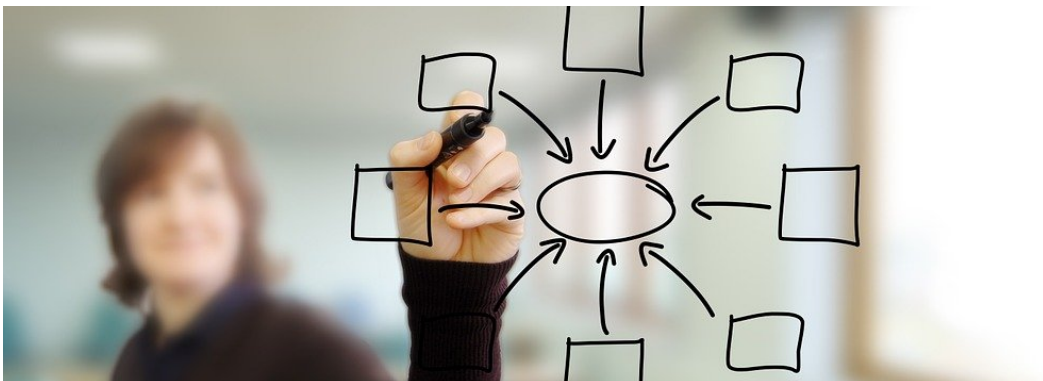
According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “classroom” as a noun can have the following definitions:

<a href="#">academy</a>	A society or institution of distinguished scholars and artists or scientists that aims to promote and maintain standards in its particular field. <i>A police <b>academy</b>.</i>
<a href="#">auditorium</a>	The area of a theater or concert hall where the audience sits. <i>The National Indoor Arena is a magnificent <b>auditorium</b> and one of Britain's premier indoor venues.</i>
<b>blackboard</b>	Sheet of slate; for writing with chalk.
<b>cafeteria</b>	A restaurant in which customers serve themselves from a counter and pay before eating. <i>Employers who offer <b>cafeteria</b> plans and other flexible programs.</i>
<a href="#">campus</a>	The grounds of a school, hospital, or other institution. <i>For the first year I had a room on <b>campus</b>.</i>
<b>canteen</b>	A recreation room in an institution.
<b>chalk</b>	A series of strata consisting mainly of chalk. <i>The menu was <b>chalked</b> up on a blackboard.</i>
<b>college</b>	The teaching staff and students of a college considered collectively. <i>The Oxford <b>colleges</b>.</i>
<b>diploma</b>	An official document or charter.
<a href="#">dorm</a>	A dormitory.
<b>dormitory</b>	A large bedroom for a number of people in a school or institution. <i>He visited the boarders in their <b>dormitory</b>.</i>
<a href="#">educator</a>	Someone who educates young people. <i>The perspective of a professional <b>educator</b>.</i>
<b>extracurricular</b>	Outside the normal routine, especially that provided by a job or marriage. <i>The <b>extracurricular</b> activities of a philandering husband.</i>
<b>grad</b>	One-hundredth of a right angle.
<b>gymnasium</b>	A room or building equipped for gymnastics, games, and other physical exercise.
<b>homeroom</b>	A classroom in which a group of students assembles daily with the same teacher before dispersing to other classes.
<b>indoor</b>	Relating to sports played indoors. <i>An <b>indoor</b> setting.</i>
<b>instructor</b>	A person who teaches something. <i>A driving <b>instructor</b>.</i>

<a href="#"><u>library</u></a>	A collection of books and periodicals held in a library. A <b>library</b> book.
<b>matriculate</b>	A person who has matriculated. <i>The arms have been <b>matriculated</b> by the Lord Lyon King of Arms in Edinburgh.</i>
<b>pedagogics</b>	The principles and methods of instruction.
<b>pedagogy</b>	The method and practice of teaching, especially as an academic subject or theoretical concept. <i><b>Pedagogy</b> is recognized as an important profession.</i>
<b>pupil</b>	The contractile aperture in the center of the iris of the eye; resembles a large black dot. <i>Will you take me on as your <b>pupil</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>school</u></a>	A day s work at school. <i>I never took <b>schools</b> I was ill.</i>
<b>schoolmaster</b>	An experienced horse that is used to train or give confidence to inexperienced riders or horses.
<b>teach</b>	A teacher. <i>He came one day each week to <b>teach</b> painting.</i>
<a href="#"><u>teacher</u></a>	A person whose occupation is teaching. <i>A history <b>teacher</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>trainee</u></a>	Someone who is being trained. <i><b>Trainee</b> solicitors.</i>
<b>undergraduate</b>	Denoting or relating to an undergraduate. <i>A group of Oxford <b>undergraduates</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>university</u></a>	The body of faculty and students at a university. <i>His daughter is at <b>university</b>.</i>
