Infinitive	to claver
Present Tense	claver / clavers
Past Tense	clavered
Present Participle	clavering
Past Participle	clavered

# **Conjugate Claver**

#### **Claver in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I claver	We <b>claver</b>
You <b>claver</b>	You <b>claver</b>
He/She/It clavers	They claver

### **Claver in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am clavering	We are clavering
You <b>are clavering</b>	You <b>are clavering</b>
He/She/It is clavering	They are clavering

#### **Claver in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have clavered	We have clavered
You have clavered	You have clavered
He/She/It has clavered	They have clavered

#### **Claver in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been clavering	We have been clavering
You <b>have been clavering</b>	You <b>have been clavering</b>
He/She/It has been clavering	They have been clavering

## **Claver in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I clavered	We <b>clavered</b>
You <b>clavered</b>	You <b>clavered</b>
He/She/It clavered	They <b>clavered</b>

#### **Claver in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was clavering	We were clavering
You were clavering	You were clavering
He/She/It was clavering	They were clavering

#### **Claver in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had clavered	We had clavered
You had clavered	You had clavered
He/She/It had clavered They had clavered	

#### **Claver in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been clavering	We had been clavering
You <b>had been clavering</b>	You had been clavering
He/She/It had been clavering	They had been clavering

#### **Claver in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will claver	We will claver
You <b>will claver</b>	You <b>will claver</b>
He/She/It will claver	They will claver

#### **Claver in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

SingularPluralI will be claveringWe will be claveringYou will be claveringYou will be claveringHe/She/It will be claveringThey will be clavering

#### **Claver in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have clavered	We will have clavered
You <b>will have clavered</b>	You will have clavered
He/She/It will have clavered	They will have clavered

## **Claver in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been clavering	We <b>will have been clavering</b>
You <b>will have been clavering</b>	You <b>will have been clavering</b>
He/She/It will have been clavering	They will have been clavering
