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## Associations of "Cleanliness" (30 Words)

<b>abstinence</b>	Act or practice of refraining from indulging an appetite. <i>I started drinking again after six years of <b>abstinence</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><b>antiseptic</b></a>	An antiseptic compound or preparation. <i>Come into the house and have some <b>antiseptic</b> put on that wound.</i>
<a href="#"><b>assay</b></a>	Attempt. <i>Each <b>assay</b> was performed in duplicate.</i>
<b>chastity</b>	The state or practice of refraining from extramarital, or especially from all, sexual intercourse. <i>Vows of <b>chastity</b>.</i>
<b>clean</b>	Free from dirt or impurities or having clean habits. <i><b>Clean</b> up before you see your grandparents.</i>
<b>diaper</b>	Put a nappy on (a baby).
<b>disinfect</b>	Destroy microorganisms or pathogens by cleansing. <i>Chlorine has been used to <b>disinfect</b> water in pools for many years.</i>
<b>disinfectant</b>	A chemical liquid that destroys bacteria. <i>Cleansing and <b>disinfectant</b> products.</i>
<b>disinfection</b>	Treatment to destroy harmful microorganisms. <i>Instruments must undergo high level <b>disinfection</b> before reuse.</i>
<a href="#"><b>disposable</b></a>	(of an article) intended to be thrown away after use. <i>Every <b>disposable</b> piece of equipment was sent to the fire.</i>
<b>fumigate</b>	Treat with fumes, expose to fumes, especially with the aim of disinfecting or eradicating pests. <i>We got sulphur candles to <b>fumigate</b> the house.</i>
<b>guiltless</b>	Free from evil or guilt. <i>People are forever criticizing the service and I am not myself <b>guiltless</b> in this.</i>

<b>healthy</b>	Promoting health; healthful- C.B.Davis. <b>Healthy</b> and normal outlets for youthful energy.
<b>honour</b>	Bestow honor or rewards upon. An <b>honours</b> degree in mathematics.
<b>hygiene</b>	Conditions or practices conducive to maintaining health and preventing disease, especially through cleanliness. Personal <b>hygiene</b> .
<b>hygienic</b>	Conducive to maintaining health and preventing disease, especially by being clean; sanitary. <b>Hygienic</b> conditions.
<b>innocence</b>	The quality of innocent naivete. All the boys lost their <b>innocence</b> with her.
<b>laundry</b>	The action or process of washing clothes and linen. Cooking and <b>laundry</b> were undertaken by domestic staff.
<b>neatly</b>	In a neat way. She <b>neatly</b> sidestepped the question.
<b>purity</b>	Freedom from adulteration or contamination. White roses represent <b>purity</b> and innocence.
<b>sanitary</b>	Relating to the conditions that affect hygiene and health, especially the supply of sewage facilities and clean drinking water. The most convenient and <b>sanitary</b> way to get rid of food waste from your kitchen.
<b>sanitation</b>	The state of being clean and conducive to health. They could afford to erect new dwellings with a reasonable standard of construction and <b>sanitation</b> .
<b>sterilization</b>	The process of making something free from bacteria or other living microorganisms. The food processing plant has undergone three <b>sterilizations</b> supervised by a microbiologist.
<b>sterilize</b>	Make infertile. A Scandinavian lake has been <b>sterilized</b> by rain made acid.
<b>toilet</b>	A room or building equipped with one or more toilets. Someone pushed at the <b>toilet</b> door.
<b>unspotted</b>	Unnoticed. It has an <b>unspotted</b> white throat.
<b>unstained</b>	Without soil or spot or stain. An apron keeps his clothing <b>unstained</b> .

**wash**

Wash or flow against.

*Does this material **wash**.*

**washing**

The action of washing oneself or laundering clothes bed linen etc.

*She took her **washing** around to the launderette.*

**wound**

The act of inflicting a wound.

*The new crisis has opened old **wounds**.*
