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Associations of "Cleanliness" (30 Words)

abstinence	Act or practice of refraining from indulging an appetite. <i>I started drinking again after six years of abstinence.</i>
antiseptic	An antiseptic compound or preparation. <i>Come into the house and have some antiseptic put on that wound.</i>
assay	Attempt. <i>Each assay was performed in duplicate.</i>
chastity	The state or practice of refraining from extramarital, or especially from all, sexual intercourse. <i>Vows of chastity.</i>
clean	Free from dirt or impurities or having clean habits. <i>Clean up before you see your grandparents.</i>
diaper	Put a nappy on (a baby).
disinfect	Destroy microorganisms or pathogens by cleansing. <i>Chlorine has been used to disinfect water in pools for many years.</i>
disinfectant	A chemical liquid that destroys bacteria. <i>Cleansing and disinfectant products.</i>
disinfection	Treatment to destroy harmful microorganisms. <i>Instruments must undergo high level disinfection before reuse.</i>
disposable	(of an article) intended to be thrown away after use. <i>Every disposable piece of equipment was sent to the fire.</i>
fumigate	Treat with fumes, expose to fumes, especially with the aim of disinfecting or eradicating pests. <i>We got sulphur candles to fumigate the house.</i>
guiltless	Free from evil or guilt. <i>People are forever criticizing the service and I am not myself guiltless in this.</i>

healthy	Promoting health; healthful- C.B.Davis. Healthy and normal outlets for youthful energy.
honour	Bestow honor or rewards upon. An honours degree in mathematics.
hygiene	Conditions or practices conducive to maintaining health and preventing disease, especially through cleanliness. Personal hygiene .
hygienic	Conducive to maintaining health and preventing disease, especially by being clean; sanitary. Hygienic conditions.
innocence	The quality of innocent naivete. All the boys lost their innocence with her.
laundry	The action or process of washing clothes and linen. Cooking and laundry were undertaken by domestic staff.
neatly	In a neat way. She neatly sidestepped the question.
purity	Freedom from adulteration or contamination. White roses represent purity and innocence.
sanitary	Relating to the conditions that affect hygiene and health, especially the supply of sewage facilities and clean drinking water. The most convenient and sanitary way to get rid of food waste from your kitchen.
sanitation	The state of being clean and conducive to health. They could afford to erect new dwellings with a reasonable standard of construction and sanitation .
sterilization	The process of making something free from bacteria or other living microorganisms. The food processing plant has undergone three sterilizations supervised by a microbiologist.
sterilize	Make infertile. A Scandinavian lake has been sterilized by rain made acid.
toilet	A room or building equipped with one or more toilets. Someone pushed at the toilet door.
unspotted	Unnoticed. It has an unspotted white throat.
unstained	Without soil or spot or stain. An apron keeps his clothing unstained .

wash

Wash or flow against.
*Does this material **wash**.*

washing

The action of washing oneself or laundering clothes bed linen etc.
*She took her **washing** around to the launderette.*

wound

The act of inflicting a wound.
*The new crisis has opened old **wounds**.*
