## Associations of "Clear as mud" (30 Words)

<a href="#">apparent</a>	Clearly visible or understood; obvious. <i>It became <b>apparent</b> that he was talented.</i>
<a href="#">assuredly</a>	Used to express the speaker’s certainty that something is true. <i>Potted roses will most <b>assuredly</b> not survive winter without protection.</i>
<a href="#">candor</a>	The quality of being honest and straightforward in attitude and speech.
<a href="#">certainly</a>	Used to emphasize the speaker’s belief that what is said is true. <i>Our current revenues are <b>certainly</b> lower than anticipated.</i>
<a href="#">clarity</a>	The quality of being easy to see or hear; sharpness of image or sound. <i>For the sake of <b>clarity</b> each of these strategies is dealt with separately.</i>
clearly	In a clear manner; with clarity. <i>Her ability to write <b>clearly</b>.</i>
crystalline	Very clear. <i>Granite is <b>crystalline</b>.</i>
decidedly	Without question and beyond doubt. <i>No Donna said <b>decidedly</b>.</i>
definitely	Without doubt (used for emphasis). <i>I shall <b>definitely</b> be at the airport to meet you.</i>
<a href="#">doubtless</a>	Presumably or very probably. <i><b>Doubtless</b> you ll solve the problem.</i>
<a href="#">explicit</a>	Of a person stating something in an explicit manner. <i>She made her wishes <b>explicit</b>.</i>
expressly	For a specific purpose; solely. <i>She was <b>expressly</b> forbidden to use the stove.</i>
indubitable	Too obvious to be doubted. <i>An <b>indubitable</b> truth.</i>

<b>indubitably</b>	In a manner or to a degree that could not be doubted. <i>It was immediately and <b>indubitably</b> apparent that I had interrupted a scene of lovers.</i>
<b>limpid</b>	Clear and bright. <i>Writes in a <b>limpid</b> style.</i>
<b>lucid</b>	Transmitting light; able to be seen through with clarity. <b>Lucid</b> directions.
<b>obvious</b>	Predictable and lacking in subtlety. <i>Unemployment has been the most <b>obvious</b> cost of the recession.</i>
<b>pellucid</b>	(of language) transparently clear; easily understandable. <i>His <b>pellucid</b> singing tone.</i>
<b>perspicuity</b>	Clarity as a consequence of being perspicuous.
<b>perspicuous</b>	(of language) transparently clear; easily understandable. <i>It provides simpler and more <b>perspicuous</b> explanations than its rivals.</i>
<b>plain</b>	Express complaints discontent displeasure or unhappiness. <i>Made his meaning <b>plain</b>.</i>
<b>simple</b>	A person lacking intelligence or common sense. <i>A <b>simple</b> design.</i>
<b>straightforward</b>	Free from ambiguity. <i>A <b>straightforward</b> gaze.</i>
<b>surely</b>	Definitely or positively sure is sometimes used informally for surely. <i>If he did not heed the warning he would <b>surely</b> die.</i>
<b>transparent</b>	(of an organization or its activities) open to public scrutiny. <i>A <b>transparent</b> explanation.</i>
<b>unambiguous</b>	Not open to more than one interpretation. <i>Instructions should be <b>unambiguous</b>.</i>
<b>undoubtedly</b>	Without doubt; certainly. <i>They are <b>undoubtedly</b> guilty.</i>
<b>unequivocal</b>	Leaving no doubt; unambiguous. <i>Took an <b>unequivocal</b> position.</i>
<b>univocal</b>	(of a word or term) having only one possible meaning; unambiguous. <i>An unequivocal or <b>univocal</b> statement.</i>
<b>unquestionably</b>	Without question and beyond doubt. <i>The awards were <b>unquestionably</b> deserved.</i>
