Associations of "Clear as mud" (30 Words)

apparent	Clearly visible or understood; obvious. <i>It became apparent that he was talented.</i>
assuredly	Used to express the speaker’s certainty that something is true. <i>Potted roses will most assuredly not survive winter without protection.</i>
candor	The quality of being honest and straightforward in attitude and speech.
certainly	Used to emphasize the speaker’s belief that what is said is true. <i>Our current revenues are certainly lower than anticipated.</i>
clarity	The quality of being easy to see or hear; sharpness of image or sound. <i>For the sake of clarity each of these strategies is dealt with separately.</i>
clearly	In a clear manner; with clarity. <i>Her ability to write clearly.</i>
crystalline	Very clear. <i>Granite is crystalline.</i>
decidedly	Without question and beyond doubt. <i>No Donna said decidedly.</i>
definitely	Without doubt (used for emphasis). <i>I shall definitely be at the airport to meet you.</i>
doubtless	Presumably or very probably. <i>Doubtless you ll solve the problem.</i>
explicit	Of a person stating something in an explicit manner. <i>She made her wishes explicit.</i>
expressly	For a specific purpose; solely. <i>She was expressly forbidden to use the stove.</i>
indubitable	Too obvious to be doubted. <i>An indubitable truth.</i>

indubitably	In a manner or to a degree that could not be doubted. <i>It was immediately and indubitably apparent that I had interrupted a scene of lovers.</i>
limpid	Clear and bright. <i>Writes in a limpid style.</i>
lucid	Transmitting light; able to be seen through with clarity. Lucid directions.
obvious	Predictable and lacking in subtlety. <i>Unemployment has been the most obvious cost of the recession.</i>
pellucid	(of language) transparently clear; easily understandable. <i>His pellucid singing tone.</i>
perspicuity	Clarity as a consequence of being perspicuous.
perspicuous	(of language) transparently clear; easily understandable. <i>It provides simpler and more perspicuous explanations than its rivals.</i>
plain	Express complaints discontent displeasure or unhappiness. <i>Made his meaning plain.</i>
simple	A person lacking intelligence or common sense. <i>A simple design.</i>
straightforward	Free from ambiguity. <i>A straightforward gaze.</i>
surely	Definitely or positively sure is sometimes used informally for surely. <i>If he did not heed the warning he would surely die.</i>
transparent	(of an organization or its activities) open to public scrutiny. <i>A transparent explanation.</i>
unambiguous	Not open to more than one interpretation. <i>Instructions should be unambiguous.</i>
undoubtedly	Without doubt; certainly. <i>They are undoubtedly guilty.</i>
unequivocal	Leaving no doubt; unambiguous. <i>Took an unequivocal position.</i>
univocal	(of a word or term) having only one possible meaning; unambiguous. <i>An unequivocal or univocal statement.</i>
unquestionably	Without question and beyond doubt. <i>The awards were unquestionably deserved.</i>
