She made her wishes **explicit**.

expresslyFor a specific purpose; solely.

She was **expressly** forbidden to use the stove.

indubitable Too obvious to be doubted.

An **indubitable** truth.



In a manner or to a degree that could not be doubted.

indubitably It was immediately and **indubitably** apparent that I had interrupted a

limpid Clear and bright.

Writes in a limpid style.

lucid Transmitting light; able to be seen through with clarity.

Lucid directions.

obvious Predictable and lacking in subtlety.

Unemployment has been the most **obvious** cost of the recession.

pellucid (of language) transparently clear; easily understandable.

His **pellucid** singing tone.

perspicuity Clarity as a consequence of being perspicuous.

(of language) transparently clear; easily understandable.

It provides simpler and more **perspicuous** explanations than its rivals.

plain Express complaints discontent displeasure or unhappiness.

Made his meaning **plain**.

univocal (of a word or term) having only one possible meaning; unambiguous.

An unequivocal or **univocal** statement.

unquestionably Without question and beyond doubt.

The awards were **unquestionably** deserved.
