apparent	Clearly revealed to the mind or the senses or judgment. <i>The effects of the drought are apparent to anyone who sees the parched fields.</i>
assuredly	Used to express the speaker’s certainty that something is true. <i>Potted roses will most assuredly not survive winter without protection.</i>
candor	The quality of being honest and straightforward in attitude and speech.
certainly	Used to emphasize the speaker’s belief that what is said is true. <i>The prestigious address certainly adds to the firm s appeal.</i>
clarity	The quality of transparency or purity. <i>It was clarity of purpose that he needed.</i>
clearly	Without doubt; obviously. <i>Her ability to write clearly.</i>
crystalline	Distinctly or sharply outlined- John Buchan. <i>Granite is crystalline.</i>
decidedly	In a decisive and confident way. <i>He looked decidedly uncomfortable.</i>
definitely	In a definite manner; clearly. <i>I shall definitely be at the airport to meet you.</i>
doubtless	Certainly; without doubt. <i>The company would doubtless find the reduced competition to their liking.</i>
explicit	Of a person stating something in an explicit manner. <i>She made her wishes explicit.</i>
expressly	Explicitly; clearly. <i>She was expressly forbidden to use the stove.</i>
indubitable	Impossible to doubt; unquestionable. <i>An indubitable truth.</i>

indubitably	In a manner or to a degree that could not be doubted. <i>Indubitably liberalism parades under many guises.</i>
limpid	(of a person's eyes) unclouded; clear. <i>Could see the sand on the bottom of the limpid pool.</i>
lucid	(of language) transparently clear; easily understandable. <i>Lucid air.</i>
obvious	Predictable and lacking in subtlety. <i>It was obvious a storm was coming in.</i>
overt	Done or shown openly; plainly apparent. <i>In untreated cases overt psychosis may occur.</i>
pellucid	Easily understood; lucid. <i>A pellucid brook.</i>
perspicuity	Clarity as a consequence of being perspicuous.
perspicuous	Able to give an account or express an idea clearly. <i>A perspicuous argument.</i>
plain	Unmistakably plain is often used informally for plainly. <i>Made his meaning plain.</i>
simple	Having few parts; not complex or complicated or involved. <i>A quiet unassuming man with simple tastes.</i>
straightforward	Without evasion or compromise. <i>A straightforward gaze.</i>
surely	Definitely or positively sure is sometimes used informally for surely. <i>If he did not heed the warning he would surely die.</i>
transparent	Transmitting light; able to be seen through with clarity. <i>If you had transparent government procurement corruption would go away.</i>
unambiguous	Not open to more than one interpretation. <i>As a horror apartheid is absolutely unambiguous.</i>
undoubtedly	Without doubt; certainly. <i>It is undoubtedly very beautiful.</i>
unequivocal	Admitting of no doubt or misunderstanding; having only one meaning or interpretation and leading to only one conclusion. <i>An unequivocal success.</i>
unquestionably	In a way that cannot be disputed or doubted; without question. <i>The awards were unquestionably deserved.</i>
