**dazed** Unable to think or react properly; bewildered.

A dazed expression.

**discomfited** Disappointingly unsuccessful.

**discomposed** Disturbed or agitated.

Looked about with a wandering and **discomposed** air.

**disconcerted** Having self-possession upset; thrown into confusion.

Keith looked momentarily **disconcerted**.

**disoriented** Socially disoriented.

She was so **disoriented** that Joe had to walk her to her room.

dumbfounded Greatly astonished or amazed.

Jay explained to a **dumbfounded** Nick.

fuddled Confused or stupefied, especially as a result of drinking alcohol.

**Fuddled** drinkers spilt their brandy and slid beneath the table.

muddled Not arranged in order; untidy.

Such a view reflects **muddled** thinking.

**mystified** Totally perplexed and mixed up.

**nonplussed** Not disconcerted; unperturbed.

 $Henry\ looked\ completely\ \textbf{nonplussed}.$ 

**perplexed** Completely baffled; very puzzled.

**Perplexed** state of the world.

Filled with bewilderment.

The questioners were met with **puzzled** looks.

**shaken** Disturbed psychologically as if by a physical jolt or shock.

The accident left her badly **shaken**.

**stunned** Knocked unconscious by a heavy blow.

Lay semiconscious **stunned** or stupefied by the blow.

**stupefied** As if struck dumb with astonishment and surprise.

Lay semiconscious stunned or **stupefied** by the blow.

thrown Twisted together; as of filaments spun into a thread.

The **thrown** rider got back on his horse.

troubled Beset by problems or difficulties.

**Troubled** teenagers.

Deprived of courage and strength.

**unnerved** The steeplejack exhausted and **unnerved** couldn t hold on to his dangerous

perch much longer.
