Co-ordinate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I co-ordinate	We co-ordinate
You co-ordinate	You co-ordinate
He/She/It co-ordinates	They co-ordinate

Co-ordinate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am co-ordinating	We are co-ordinating
You are co-ordinating	You are co-ordinating
He/She/It is co-ordinating	They are co-ordinating

Co-ordinate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have co-ordinated	We have co-ordinated
You have co-ordinated	You have co-ordinated
He/She/It has co-ordinated	They have co-ordinated

Co-ordinate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been co-ordinating	We have been co-ordinating
You have been co-ordinating	You have been co-ordinating
He/She/It has been co-ordinating	They have been co-ordinating

Co-ordinate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I co-ordinated	We co-ordinated
You co-ordinated	You co-ordinated
He/She/It co-ordinated	They $\ensuremath{\textbf{co-ordinated}}$

Co-ordinate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was co-ordinating	We were co-ordinating
You were co-ordinating	You were co-ordinating
He/She/It was co-ordinating	They were co-ordinating

Co-ordinate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had co-ordinated	We had co-ordinated
You had co-ordinated	You had co-ordinated
He/She/It had co-ordinated	They had co-ordinated

Co-ordinate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been co-ordinating	We had been co-ordinating
You had been co-ordinating	You had been co-ordinating
He/She/It had been co-ordinating	They had been co-ordinating

Co-ordinate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will co-ordinate	We will co-ordinate
You will co-ordinate	You will co-ordinate
He/She/It will co-ordinate	They will co-ordinate

Co-ordinate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be co-ordinating	We will be co-ordinating
You will be co-ordinating	You will be co-ordinating
He/She/It will be co-ordinating	They will be co-ordinating
