# **Conjugate Cognise**

## **Cognise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I cognise	We <b>cognise</b>
You <b>cognise</b>	You <b>cognise</b>
He/She/It cognises	They <b>cognise</b>

## **Cognise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am cognising	We <b>are cognising</b>
You <b>are cognising</b>	You <b>are cognising</b>
He/She/It is cognising	They are cognising

## **Cognise in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have cognised	We have cognised
You <b>have cognised</b>	You have cognised
He/She/It has cognised	They have cognised

## **Cognise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been cognising	We have been cognising
You <b>have been cognising</b>	You have been cognising
He/She/It has been cognising	They have been cognising

## **Cognise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I cognised	We <b>cognised</b>
You <b>cognised</b>	You <b>cognised</b>
He/She/It cognised	They <b>cognised</b>

## **Cognise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

## **Cognise in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had cognised	We had cognised
You <b>had cognised</b>	You had cognised
He/She/It had cognised	They had cognised

## **Cognise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been cognising	We had been cognising
You <b>had been cognising</b>	You had been cognising
He/She/It had been cognising	They had been cognising

## **Cognise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will cognise	We <b>will cognise</b>
You <b>will cognise</b>	You <b>will cognise</b>
He/She/It will cognise	They will cognise

## **Cognise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be cognising	We will be cognising
You <b>will be cognising</b>	You will be cognising
He/She/It will be cognising	They will be cognising

#### **Cognise in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have cognised	We will have cognised
You <b>will have cognised</b>	You will have cognised
He/She/It will have cognised	They will have cognised

## **Cognise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been cognising	We <b>will have been cognising</b>
You <b>will have been cognising</b>	You <b>will have been cognising</b>
He/She/It will have been cognising They will have been cognising
