coif	A skullcap worn by nuns under a veil or by soldiers under a hood of mail or formerly by British sergeants-at-law. <i>Her black habit and white starched coif.</i>
cut	The act of cutting something into parts. <i>A good lean cut of beef.</i>
hair	Filamentous hairlike growth on a plant. <i>He combed his hair.</i>
hair style	A covering for the body (or parts of it) consisting of a dense growth of threadlike structures (as on the human head); helps to prevent heat loss.
haircut	The act of cutting the hair. <i>He s always very particular about his haircut.</i>
hairdo	The arrangement of the hair (especially a woman's hair). <i>An elaborate bouffant hairdo.</i>
hairstyle	The arrangement of the hair (especially a woman's hair).
style	In an invertebrate a small slender pointed appendage a stylet. <i>The concerto is composed in a neoclassical style.</i>

coiffe	Arrange attractively.
do	Get something done. <i>Hi how are you doing today.</i>
dress	Dress or groom with elaborate care. Dress the victim's wounds.
set	Set in type. Set the table.

appearance	The way that someone or something looks. <i>The sudden appearance of her daughter startled her.</i>
barber	Perform the services of a barber cut the hair and or beard of. <i>His hair was neatly barbered.</i>
barbershop	A popular style of close harmony singing, typically for four male voices. <i>A barbershop quartet.</i>
beard	Go along the rim like a beard around the chin. <i>He was afraid to beard the sultan himself.</i>
braided	(of a garment) edged or trimmed with braid. Braided red trousers.

conditioner	A trainer of athletes. <i>Add a water conditioner to neutralize chlorine.</i>
crimp	A small connecting piece for crimping wires or lines together. <i>The crimp on take home pay has been even tighter since taxes were raised.</i>
curl	With reference to a person's hair a state or condition of being curled. <i>Large perm rods give volume and control rather than lots of curl.</i>
curly	(of hair) having curls or waves. <i>They envied her naturally curly hair.</i>
designer	Made or designed by a famous and prestigious fashion designer. <i>He's one of the world's leading car designers.</i>
frizz	Dress (chamois or a similar leather) with pumice or a scraping knife. <i>A perm system designed to add curl without frizz.</i>
frizzle	Fry something until it curls and becomes crisp. <i>She frizzled the bacon and poached the eggs.</i>

gyre	Whirl or gyrate. <i>The central North Pacific gyre.</i>
hackles	A feeling of anger and animosity. <i>Having one s hackles or dander up.</i>
hair	Filamentous hairlike growth on a plant. <i>There is a hair in my soup.</i>
haircut	The style in which hair has been cut. <i>He s always very particular about his haircut.</i>
hairstyle	A particular way in which a person's hair is cut or arranged.
look	Of a building or room have an outlook in a specified direction. <i>He had charm good looks and an amusing insouciance.</i>
loop	Follow a course that forms a loop or loops. <i>Make a loop in the twine.</i>
moustache	A growth similar to a moustache or a marking that resembles one round the mouth of some animals. <i>A clergyman with long grey moustaches.</i>
mustache	An unshaved growth of hair on the upper lip. <i>He looked younger after he shaved off his mustache.</i>
perm	Set the hair in a perm. <i>She perms her hair.</i>
ringlet	A brown butterfly with wings bearing eyespots. <i>Her hair fell loose in ringlets.</i>
shave	Cut (a thin slice or slices) from the surface of something. <i>The machine shaved off fine layers from the piece of wood.</i>
short	Create a short circuit in. <i>I was caught short.</i>
shorten	Make or become shorter. <i>Ladbrokes shortened Nashwan s odds from 2 1 to 7 4.</i>
tonsure	Shave the hair on top of a monk s or priest s head give a tonsure to. <i>He received the tonsure.</i>
weave	Include an element in (a story or pattern). <i>He weaves colourful cinematic plots.</i>
whorl	A pattern of spirals or concentric circles. <i>Shelley drew larger and larger dark whorls on her notepad.</i>
