<b>hair</b>	Filamentous hairlike growth on a plant. <i>He combed his <b>hair</b>.</i>
<b>hair style</b>	A covering for the body (or parts of it) consisting of a dense growth of threadlike structures (as on the human head); helps to prevent heat loss.
<b>haircut</b>	The act of cutting the hair. <i>He s always very particular about his <b>haircut</b>.</i>
<b>hairdo</b>	The arrangement of the hair (especially a woman's hair). <i>An elaborate bouffant <b>hairdo</b>.</i>
<b>hairstyle</b>	The arrangement of the hair (especially a woman's hair).
<b>style</b>	In an invertebrate a small slender pointed appendage a stylet. <i>The concerto is composed in a neoclassical <b>style</b>.</i>

<b>coif</b>	Cover with a coif. <i>Her <b>coiffed</b> blonde hair.</i>

- curl** With reference to a person's hair a state or condition of being curled.  
*Large perm rods give volume and control rather than lots of **curl**.*
- curly** (of hair) having curls or waves.  
*They envied her naturally **curly** hair.*
- designer** Made or designed by a famous and prestigious fashion designer.  
*He's one of the world's leading car **designers**.*
- frizz** Dress (chamois or a similar leather) with pumice or a scraping knife.  
*A perm system designed to add curl without **frizz**.*
- frizzle** Fry something until it curls and becomes crisp.  
*She **frizzled** the bacon and poached the eggs.*

<b>gyre</b>	Whirl or gyrate. <i>The central North Pacific <b>gyre</b>.</i>
<b>hackles</b>	A feeling of anger and animosity. <i>Having one s <b>hackles</b> or dander up.</i>
<b>hair</b>	Filamentous hairlike growth on a plant. <i>There is a <b>hair</b> in my soup.</i>
<b>haircut</b>	The style in which hair has been cut. <i>He s always very particular about his <b>haircut</b>.</i>
<b>hairstyle</b>	A particular way in which a person's hair is cut or arranged.
<b>look</b>	Of a building or room have an outlook in a specified direction. <i>He had charm good <b>looks</b> and an amusing insouciance.</i>
<b>loop</b>	Follow a course that forms a loop or loops. <i>Make a <b>loop</b> in the twine.</i>
<b>moustache</b>	A growth similar to a moustache or a marking that resembles one round the mouth of some animals. <i>A clergyman with long grey <b>moustaches</b>.</i>
<b>mustache</b>	An unshaved growth of hair on the upper lip. <i>He looked younger after he shaved off his <b>mustache</b>.</i>
<b>perm</b>	Set the hair in a perm. <i>She <b>perms</b> her hair.</i>
<b>ringlet</b>	A brown butterfly with wings bearing eyespots. <i>Her hair fell loose in <b>ringlets</b>.</i>
<b>shave</b>	Cut (a thin slice or slices) from the surface of something. <i>The machine <b>shaved</b> off fine layers from the piece of wood.</i>
<b>short</b>	Create a short circuit in. <i>I was caught <b>short</b>.</i>
<b>shorten</b>	Make or become shorter. <i>Ladbroke's <b>shortened</b> Nashwan's odds from 2 1 to 7 4.</i>
<b>tonsure</b>	Shave the hair on top of a monk's or priest's head give a tonsure to. <i>He received the <b>tonsure</b>.</i>
<b>weave</b>	Include an element in (a story or pattern). <i>He <b>weaves</b> colourful cinematic plots.</i>
<b>whorl</b>	A pattern of spirals or concentric circles. <i>Shelley drew larger and larger dark <b>whorls</b> on her notepad.</i>
