He/She/It **collations** They **collation**

## **Collation in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am collationing**

We **are collationing**

You **are collationing**

You **are collationing**

He/She/It **is collationing** They **are collationing**

## **Collation in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have collationed**

We **have collationed**

You **have collationed**

You **have collationed**

He/She/It **has collationed** They **have collationed**

I **had collationed**                      We **had collationed**

I **had been collationing**              We **had been collationing**  
You **had been collationing**          You **had been collationing**  
He/She/It **had been collationing**      They **had been collationing**

I **will collation**                      We **will collation**  
You **will collation**                  You **will collation**  
He/She/It **will collation**      They **will collation**

I **will be collationing**                  We **will be collationing**  
You **will be collationing**              You **will be collationing**  
He/She/It **will be collationing**      They **will be collationing**

**I will have collationed**

**We will have collationed**

**You will have collationed**

**You will have collationed**
