Present Tense	<b>collor / collors</b>
Past Tense	<b>colored</b>
Present Participle	<b>colloring</b>
Past Participle	<b>colored</b>

## Conjugate Collor

**Collor in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>collor</b>	We <b>collor</b>
You <b>collor</b>	You <b>collor</b>
He/She/It <b>collors</b>	They <b>collor</b>

## **Collor in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am colloring</b>	We <b>are colloring</b>
You <b>are colloring</b>	You <b>are colloring</b>
He/She/It <b>is colloring</b>	They <b>are colloring</b>

## **Collor in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have collored</b>	We <b>have collored</b>
You <b>have collored</b>	You <b>have collored</b>
He/She/It <b>has collored</b>	They <b>have collored</b>

## **Collor in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been colloring</b>	We <b>have been colloring</b>
You <b>have been colloring</b>	You <b>have been colloring</b>
He/She/It <b>has been colloring</b>	They <b>have been colloring</b>

## **Collor in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>collored</b>	We <b>collored</b>
You <b>collored</b>	You <b>collored</b>
He/She/It <b>collored</b>	They <b>collored</b>

## **Collor in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

I <b>was colloring</b>	We <b>were colloring</b>
You <b>were colloring</b>	You <b>were colloring</b>
He/She/It <b>was colloring</b>	They <b>were colloring</b>

**Collor in Past Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>had collored</b>	We <b>had collored</b>
You <b>had collored</b>	You <b>had collored</b>
He/She/It <b>had collored</b>	They <b>had collored</b>

**Collor in Past Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>had been colloring</b>	We <b>had been colloring</b>
You <b>had been colloring</b>	You <b>had been colloring</b>
He/She/It <b>had been colloring</b>	They <b>had been colloring</b>

**Collor in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>will collor</b>	We <b>will collor</b>
You <b>will collor</b>	You <b>will collor</b>
He/She/It <b>will collor</b>	They <b>will collor</b>

**Collor in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>will be colloring</b>	We <b>will be colloring</b>
You <b>will be colloring</b>	You <b>will be colloring</b>
He/She/It <b>will be colloring</b>	They <b>will be colloring</b>

**We will have collored**

**You will have collored**

**They will have collored**

**We will have been colloring**

**You will have been colloring**

**You will have been colloring**

**He/She/It will have been colloring**

**They will have been colloring**
