I am colorating We are colorating
You are colorating You are colorating
He/She/It is colorating They are colorating

Colorate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have colorated We have colorated You have colorated You have colorated He/She/It has colorated They have colorated

Colorate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been colorating
You have been colorating
He/She/It has been colorating
They have been colorating

Colorate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was colorating We were colorating
You were colorating
He/She/It was colorating They were colorating

Colorate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had colorated We had colorated
You had colorated You had colorated
He/She/It had colorated They had colorated

Colorate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been colorating We had been colorating
You had been colorating You had been colorating
He/She/It had been colorating They had been colorating

Colorate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will colorate
You will colorate
He/She/It will colorate
They will colorate

Colorate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be colorating
You will be colorating
He/She/It will be colorating
They will be colorating

Colorate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have colorated We will have colorated You will have colorated He/She/It will have colorated They will have colorated

I will have been colorating
You will have been colorating
He/She/It will have been colorating
They will have been colorating
