<b>blue</b>	Of a person's skin having turned blue as a result of cold or breathing difficulties. <i>Far out upon the <b>blue</b> were many sails.</i>
<b>brilliantly</b>	With brightness. <i>He seems to be coping <b>brilliantly</b>.</i>
<b>colored</b>	Having skin rich in melanin pigments. <i><b>Colored</b> crepe paper.</i>

<b>discolor</b>	Lose color or turn colorless. <i>The painting <b>discolored</b>.</i>
<b>dye</b>	Add a colour to or change the colour of something by soaking it in a solution impregnated with a dye. <i>A black <b>dye</b>.</i>
<b>hue</b>	The quality of a color as determined by its dominant wavelength. <i>The water is the deepest <b>hue</b> of aquamarine.</i>
<b>iridescent</b>	Having a play of lustrous rainbow colors. <i>The drake s head has an <b>iridescent</b> purple sheen.</i>
<b>monochromatic</b>	(of light or other radiation) of a single wavelength or frequency. <i>It employs diffraction to focus <b>monochromatic</b> light.</i>
<b>monochrome</b>	Having or appearing to have only one color.
<b>motley</b>	A garment made of motley especially a court jester s costume. <i>A <b>motley</b> crew.</i>
<b>opalescent</b>	Showing many small points of shifting colour against a pale or dark ground. <i>A milky <b>opalescent</b> or opaline luster.</i>
<b>orange</b>	Used in names of plants with similar fruit or flowers to the orange tree e g mock orange. <i><b>Orange</b> juice.</i>
<b>paint</b>	Basketball a space including the foul line in front of the basket at each end of a basketball court usually painted a different color from the rest of the court. <i>The program enables you to <b>paint</b> images on your screen.</i>
<b>painted</b>	Coated with paint. <i>Freshly <b>painted</b> lawn furniture.</i>
<b>palette</b>	One of the rounded armor plates at the armpits of a suit of armor. <i>He commands the sort of tonal <b>palette</b> which this music needs.</i>
<b>piebald</b>	A piebald horse. <i>A <b>piebald</b> horse.</i>
<b>pie</b>	Having sections or patches colored differently and usually brightly. <i><b>Pied</b> daisies.</i>
<b>pigment</b>	Colour something with or as if with pigment. <i>Carotenoid <b>pigments</b> are red orange or yellow.</i>
<b>pigmentation</b>	Abnormal colouring of a person's skin, typically resulting from disease.
<b>polychrome</b>	Color with many colors make polychrome. <i>Painters gilded and <b>polychromed</b> the wooden carvings.</i>

<b>purple</b>	Become purple. <i><b>Purple</b> tyrant.</i>
<b>red</b>	A red light. <i>The company was 4 million in the <b>red</b>.</i>
<b>roan</b>	A roan animal. <i>A blue <b>roan</b>.</i>
<b>smear</b>	Stain by smearing or daubing with a dirty substance. <i>There was an oil <b>smear</b> on his jacket.</i>
<b>spot</b>	Make a spot or mark onto. <i>They changed his <b>spot</b> on the program.</i>
<b>stain</b>	Produce or leave stains. <i>The awful events would unfairly <b>stain</b> the city's reputation.</i>
<b>stained</b>	Marked or dyed or discolored with foreign matter. <i>A <b>stained</b> beer mat.</i>
<b>tint</b>	Dye someone's hair with a tint. <i>A <b>tint</b> of glamour.</i>
<b>variegate</b>	Change the appearance of, especially by marking with different colors. <i>The musicians <b>variegate</b> the pitch.</i>
<b>white</b>	The white part of an egg the nutritive and protective gelatinous substance surrounding the yolk consisting mainly of albumin dissolved in water. <i>Wide <b>white</b> margins.</i>
