Columbus in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I **columbus** We **columbus** You **columbus** You **columbus**

He/She/It columbuses They columbus

Columbus in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am columbusing We are columbusing
You are columbusing You are columbusing
He/She/It is columbusing They are columbusing

Columbus in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have columbused We have columbused You have columbused You have columbused He/She/It has columbused They have columbused

Columbus in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been columbusing
You have been columbusing
You have been columbusing
He/She/It has been columbusing
They have been columbusing

Columbus in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **columbused** We **columbused**You **columbused** You **columbused**He/She/It **columbused** They **columbused**

Columbus in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was columbusing We were columbusing
You were columbusing You were columbusing
He/She/It was columbusing They were columbusing

Columbus in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had columbused We had columbused
You had columbused You had columbused
He/She/It had columbused They had columbused

Columbus in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been columbusing
You had been columbusing
He/She/It had been columbusing
They had been columbusing

Columbus in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will columbus
You will columbus
He/She/It will columbus
They will columbus

Columbus in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be columbusing
You will be columbusing
He/She/It will be columbusing
They will be columbusing

Columbus in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have columbused We will have columbused You will have columbused He/She/It will have columbused They will have columbused

Columbus in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been columbusing
You will have been columbusing
He/She/It will have been columbusing
They will have been columbusing
