Present Tense	<b>columbus / columbuses</b>
Past Tense	<b>columbused</b>
Present Participle	<b>columbusing</b>
Past Participle	<b>columbused</b>

## Conjugate Columbus

### Columbus in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>columbus</b>	We <b>columbus</b>
You <b>columbus</b>	You <b>columbus</b>
He/She/It <b>columbus</b>	They <b>columbus</b>

### **Columbus in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am columbusing</b>	We <b>are columbusing</b>
You <b>are columbusing</b>	You <b>are columbusing</b>
He/She/It <b>is columbusing</b>	They <b>are columbusing</b>

### **Columbus in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have columbused</b>	We <b>have columbused</b>
You <b>have columbused</b>	You <b>have columbused</b>
He/She/It <b>has columbused</b>	They <b>have columbused</b>

### **Columbus in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

I <b>have been columbusing</b>	We <b>have been columbusing</b>
You <b>have been columbusing</b>	You <b>have been columbusing</b>
He/She/It <b>has been columbusing</b>	They <b>have been columbusing</b>

### **Columbus in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I **was columbusing**      We **were columbusing**  
You **were columbusing**      You **were columbusing**  
He/She/It **was columbusing**      They **were columbusing**

I **had columbused**      We **had columbused**  
You **had columbused**      You **had columbused**  
He/She/It **had columbused**      They **had columbused**
