<u>regain</u>	Get or find back; recover the use of. She regain ed control of herself.
<u>repay</u>	Make repayment for or return something. Most of his fortune had been spent repay ing creditors.
resilience	The ability of a substance or object to spring back into shape; elasticity. <i>Nylon is excellent in wearability abrasion resistance and resilience.</i>
<u>restitution</u>	Recompense for injury or loss. Restitution of the damaged mucosa.
restoration	The restoration of the Bourbon monarchy in France in 1814 following the fall of Napoleon Louis XVIII was recalled from exile by Talleyrand. <i>Published restorations are dodgy based on single bones.</i>
restore	Restore by replacing a part or putting together what is torn or broken. Order was eventually restore d by riot police.
retrace	Go back over (the same route that one has just taken. I ve tried to retrace some of her movements.
retrieval	The cognitive operation of accessing information in memory. My retrieval of people s names is very poor.
retrieve	Reel or bring in a fishing line. Retrieve the car from the parking garage.
return	The key on electric typewriters or computer keyboards that causes a carriage return and a line feed. <i>The return of spring.</i>
<u>revert</u>	(of property) return to (the original owner) by reversion. If interested kindly revert with your updated resume.
staircase	A way of access (upward and downward) consisting of a set of steps. <i>He descended the broad staircase</i> .
