Commonise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I **commonise**You **commonise**He/She/It **commonises**They **commonise**

Commonise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am commonising We are commonising
You are commonising You are commonising
He/She/It is commonising They are commonising

Commonise in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have commonised We have commonised You have commonised He/She/It has commonised They have commonised

Commonise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been commonising

You have been commonising

You have been commonising

He/She/It has been commonising

They have been commonising

Commonise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **commonised** We **commonised**You **commonised** You **commonised**He/She/It **commonised** They **commonised**

Commonise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was commonising We were commonising
You were commonising You were commonising
He/She/It was commonising They were commonising

Commonise in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had commonised We had commonised
You had commonised You had commonised
He/She/It had commonised They had commonised

Commonise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been commonising
You had been commonising
He/She/It had been commonising
They had been commonising
We had been commonising
You had been commonising

Commonise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will commonise
You will commonise
He/She/It will commonise
They will commonise

Commonise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be commonising
You will be commonising
He/She/It will be commonising
They will be commonising

Commonise in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have commonised
You will have commonised
He/She/It will have commonised
They will have commonised

Commonise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been commonising
You will have been commonising
He/She/It will have been commonising
They will have been commonising
