- A person who supports or believes in the principles of communism.








#### Synonyms of "Communist" as a noun (5 Words)

- **collectivist** A person who belongs to the political left. *An entire nation of collectivists.*
- leftistA person who belongs to the political left.<br/>These values are shared by many leftists.

An atom or group of atoms with at least one unpaired electron; in the **radical socialist** body it is usually an oxygen molecule that has lost an electron and will stabilize itself by stealing an electron from a nearby molecule.

socialistA political advocate of socialism.<br/>She was a lifelong socialist.

- Relating to or marked by communism.
- Adhering to or based on the principles of communism.





## Synonyms of "Communist" as an adjective (5 Words)

collectivist	Relating to the practice or principle of giving a group priority over each individual in it. <i>Collectivist</i> policies which promised security and protection.
communistic	Relating to or marked by communism. <i>Communistic</i> propaganda.
leftist	Believing in or supporting tenets of the political left. <i>Leftist</i> rebels.
radical socialist Arising from or going to the root or source.	
socialist	Advocating or following the socialist principles. The history of <b>socialist</b> movement.

# Associations of "Communist" (30 Words)

An advocate of anarchism. An <b>anarchist</b> newspaper.
A state of disorder due to absence or non-recognition of authority or other controlling systems. <i>He must ensure public order in a country threatened with <b>anarchy</b>.</i>
A bourgeois person. A self confessed and proud <b>bourgeois</b> .
Of or relating to capitalism or capitalists. <i>Capitalist countries.</i>
A collective farm. A <b>collective</b> sigh of relief from parents.



competitive	Involving competition or competitiveness. A <b>competitive</b> sport.
<u>coup</u>	(among some North American Indian peoples) an act of touching an armed enemy in battle as a deed of bravery, or an act of first touching an item of the enemy's in order to claim it. <i>It was a major coup to get such a prestigious contract.</i>
<u>decree</u>	Issue a decree. The King <b>decree</b> d that all firstborn males should be killed.
demagogue	A political leader who seeks support by appealing to popular passions and prejudices. A gifted <b>demagogue</b> with particular skill in manipulating the press.
<u>firebrand</u>	A piece of wood that has been burned or is burning. A political <b>firebrand</b> .
heaven	Any place of complete bliss and delight and peace. The everlasting happiness with God that we call <b>heaven</b> .
idealistic	Of high moral or intellectual value; elevated in nature or style. <i>Idealistic</i> young doctors who went to work for the rebels.
incendiary	An incendiary bomb or device. <i>Incendiary</i> bombs.
insurgent	A person fighting against a government or invading force; a rebel or revolutionary. An attack by armed <b>insurgent</b> s.
libertarian	An advocate of libertarianism. No true <b>libertarian</b> would ever support a culture where citizens must show their papers to travel.
nationalize	Make national in character or scope. Mitterand <b>nationalize</b> d the banks.
nihilist	An advocate of anarchism. It is impossible to argue against a <b>nihilist</b> .
<u>politician</u>	A person who is professionally involved in politics, especially as a holder of an elected office. <i>A veteran communist</i> <b>politician</b> .
privatize	Change from governmental to private control or ownership. <i>The oil industry was <b>privatize</b>d</i> .
<u>proletariat</u>	Working-class people regarded collectively (often used with reference to Marxism. <i>The growth of the industrial <b>proletariat</b>.</i>



<u>radical</u>	Markedly new or introducing radical change. In the body free <b>radical</b> s are high energy particles that ricochet wildly and damage cells.
<u>rebel</u>	Take part in a rebellion renounce a former allegiance. <i>Rebel forces.</i>
redistribute	Distribute anew. <b>Redistribute</b> the troops more strategically.
<u>revolutionary</u>	Involving or causing a complete or dramatic change. <i>The <b>revolutionary</b> army.</i>
seditious	In opposition to a civil authority or government. The letter was declared <b>seditious</b> .
socialist	Advocating or following the socialist principles. She was a lifelong <b>socialist</b> .
<u>sublime</u>	Cause a substance to sublime. These crystals could be <b>sublime</b> d under a vacuum.
<u>subversive</u>	A subversive person. The government claimed we were <b>subversive</b> s or terrorists.
<u>utopia</u>	A work of fiction describing a utopia. Misplaced faith in political <b>utopia</b> s has led to ruin.
wealth	Plentiful supplies of a particular resource. He used his considerable <b>wealth</b> to bribe officials.
