Compenetrate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I compenetrate

You compenetrate

He/She/It compenetrates

They compenetrate

Compenetrate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am compenetrating We are compenetrating
You are compenetrating
He/She/It is compenetrating They are compenetrating

Compenetrate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have compenetrated We have compenetrated You have compenetrated You have compenetrated He/She/It has compenetrated They have compenetrated

Compenetrate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been compenetrating
You have been compenetrating
He/She/It has been compenetrating
They have been compenetrating

Compenetrate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I compenetrated We compenetrated You compenetrated You compenetrated He/She/It compenetrated They compenetrated

Compenetrate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was compenetrating
You were compenetrating
He/She/It was compenetrating
They were compenetrating

Compenetrate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had compenetrated We had compenetrated You had compenetrated He/She/It had compenetrated They had compenetrated

Compenetrate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been compenetrating
You had been compenetrating
He/She/It had been compenetrating
They had been compenetrating

Compenetrate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will compenetrate We will compenetrate
You will compenetrate
He/She/It will compenetrate They will compenetrate

Compenetrate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be compenetrating
You will be compenetrating
He/She/It will be compenetrating
They will be compenetrating

Compenetrate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have compenetrated We will have compenetrated You will have compenetrated He/She/It will have compenetrated They will have compenetrated

Compenetrate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been compenetrating
You will have been compenetrating
He/She/It will have been compenetrating
They will have been compenetrating
