Synonyms of "Complainant" as a noun (15 Words)

accused	A defendant in a criminal proceeding. <i>The accused was ordered to stand trial on a number of charges.</i>
<u>appellant</u>	The party who appeals a decision of a lower court.
claimant	A person making a claim, especially in a lawsuit or for a state benefit. <i>One in four eligible claimants failed to register for a rebate.</i>
<u>contender</u>	The contestant you hope to defeat. <i>The major contenders in the football championship.</i>
contestant	A person who dissents from some established policy. <i>An anxious contestant on a television quiz show.</i>
<u>defendant</u>	A person or institution against whom an action is brought in a court of law; the person being sued or accused. <i>The defendant tried to claim that it was self defence.</i>

disputant	A person who disputes; who is good at or enjoys controversy. <i>His reputation as both a disputant and a negotiator was well established.</i>
interest	The selfish pursuit of one's own welfare self interest. <i>An interest in music.</i>
litigator	(law) a party to a lawsuit; someone involved in litigation.
opponent	A contestant that you are matched against. <i>He beat his opponent by a landslide margin.</i>
opponent in law	Someone who offers opposition.
party	A person involved in legal proceedings. <i>The visiting party will be asked to conform to safety procedures whilst on site.</i>
petitioner	Someone who petitions a court for redress of a grievance or recovery of a right. <i>Petitioners gathered about 70 000 signatures for the initiative.</i>
plaintiff	A person who brings an action in a court of law. <i>The plaintiff commenced an action for damages.</i>
respondent	The codefendant especially in a divorce proceeding who is accused of adultery with the corespondent. <i>Most respondents to our questionnaire considered their practices to be in accordance with current medical guidelines.</i>
