Synonyms of "Complainant" as a noun (15 Words)

accused	A defendant in a criminal proceeding. The accused was ordered to stand trial on a number of charges.
<u>appellant</u>	The party who appeals a decision of a lower court.
claimant	A person making a claim, especially in a lawsuit or for a state benefit. One in four eligible claimant s failed to register for a rebate.
<u>contender</u>	The contestant you hope to defeat. The major contender s in the football championship.
contestant	A person who dissents from some established policy. An anxious contestant on a television quiz show.
<u>defendant</u>	A person or institution against whom an action is brought in a court of law; the person being sued or accused. <i>The defendant</i> tried to claim that it was self defence.



disputant	A person who disputes; who is good at or enjoys controversy. <i>His reputation as both a disputant and a negotiator was well established.</i>
interest	The selfish pursuit of one s own welfare self interest. An interest in music.
litigator	(law) a party to a lawsuit; someone involved in litigation.
opponent	A contestant that you are matched against. He beat his opponent by a landslide margin.
opponent in law	Someone who offers opposition.
party	A person involved in legal proceedings. <i>The visiting</i> party <i>will be asked to conform to safety procedures whilst on site.</i>
petitioner	Someone who petitions a court for redress of a grievance or recovery of a right. Petitioner s gathered about 70 000 signatures for the initiative.
plaintiff	A person who brings an action in a court of law. The plaintiff commenced an action for damages.
respondent	The codefendant especially in a divorce proceeding who is accused of adultery with the corespondent. Most respondent s to our questionnaire considered their practices to be in accordance with current medical guidelines.
