<b>engineering</b>	A field of study or activity concerned with modification or development in a particular area. <i>If not for his shrewd <b>engineering</b> the election would have been lost.</i>
<b>functional</b>	Relating to the way in which something works or operates. <i>A small <b>functional</b> bathroom.</i>
<b>keyboard</b>	Enter data by means of a keyboard. <i>Entries would be <b>keyboarded</b>.</i>
<b>keypad</b>	A miniature keyboard or set of buttons for operating a portable electronic device, telephone, or other equipment.
<b>laptop</b>	A computer that is portable and suitable for use while travelling.
<b>machinery</b>	Machines or machine systems collectively. <i>The complex <b>machinery</b> of negotiation.</i>
<b>mechanical</b>	A manual worker. <i>His smile was very <b>mechanical</b>.</i>
<b>microphone</b>	Device for converting sound waves into electrical energy.
<b>microprocessor</b>	An integrated circuit that contains all the functions of a central processing unit of a computer. <i>A disk drive contains a <b>microprocessor</b> to handle the internal functions of the drive.</i>
<b>modem</b>	Send data by modem. <i>Iva and Bill were <b>modeming</b> new programs to New Orleans.</i>
<b>newfangled</b>	Gratuitously new. <i><b>Newfangled</b> ideas.</i>
<b>oriented</b>	Adjusted or located in relation to surroundings or circumstances; sometimes used in combination. <i>The house had its large windows <b>oriented</b> toward the ocean view.</i>

<b>portable</b>	A small transportable building used as a classroom. <i>A <b>portable</b> outboard motor.</i>
<b><u>programming</u></b>	The process or activity of writing computer programs. <i>The <b>programming</b> of shows.</i>
<b><u>robotic</u></b>	Relating to or of the nature of robots. <i>His <b>robotic</b> voice.</i>
<b>science</b>	A particular area of science. <i>His rare <b>science</b> and his practical skill.</i>
<b><u>screen</u></b>	Separate something from something else with or as if with a screen. <i>Services offered by the centre include a health <b>screen</b> for people who have just joined the company.</i>
<b>server</b>	A computer or computer program which manages access to a centralized resource or service in a network. <i>The software runs on a variety of Unix <b>servers</b>.</i>
<b>software</b>	Written programs or procedures or rules and associated documentation pertaining to the operation of a computer system and that are stored in read/write memory. <i>The market for <b>software</b> is expected to expand.</i>
<b>technology</b>	The practical application of science to commerce or industry. <i>Advances in computer <b>technology</b>.</i>
<b>wireless</b>	An electronic receiver that detects and demodulates and amplifies transmitted signals. <i>Listening to the news on the <b>wireless</b>.</i>
<b>workstation</b>	An area where work of a particular nature is carried out, such as a specific location on an assembly line.
