Present Tense	<b>con / cons</b>
Past Tense	<b>conned</b>
Present Participle	<b>conning</b>
Past Participle	<b>conned</b>

## Conjugate Con

**Con in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>con</b>	We <b>con</b>
You <b>con</b>	You <b>con</b>
He/She/It <b>cons</b>	They <b>con</b>

### **Con in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>am conning</b>	We <b>are conning</b>
You <b>are conning</b>	You <b>are conning</b>
He/She/It <b>is conning</b>	They <b>are conning</b>

### **Con in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have conned</b>	We <b>have conned</b>
You <b>have conned</b>	You <b>have conned</b>
He/She/It <b>has conned</b>	They <b>have conned</b>

### **Con in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have been conning</b>	We <b>have been conning</b>
You <b>have been conning</b>	You <b>have been conning</b>
He/She/It <b>has been conning</b>	They <b>have been conning</b>

### **Con in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>conned</b>	We <b>conned</b>
You <b>conned</b>	You <b>conned</b>
He/She/It <b>conned</b>	They <b>conned</b>

### **Con in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was conning                      We were conning  
You were conning                You were conning  
He/She/It was conning        They were conning

**Con in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had conned                      We had conned  
You had conned                You had conned  
He/She/It had conned        They had conned

**Con in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been conning              We had been conning  
You had been conning          You had been conning  
He/She/It had been conning    They had been conning

**Con in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will con                      We will con  
You will con                You will con  
He/She/It will con        They will con

**Con in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be conning                We will be conning  
You will be conning            You will be conning  
He/She/It will be conning    They will be conning

**Con in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have conned**

**We will have conned**

**You will have conned**

**You will have conned**

**He/She/It will have conned** **They will have conned**

**Con in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been conning**

**We will have been conning**

**You will have been conning**

**You will have been conning**

**He/She/It will have been conning** **They will have been conning**
