Present Participle	conceptualising

Conjugate Conceptualise

Conceptualise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **conceptualise** We **conceptualise**
You **conceptualise** You **conceptualise**
He/She/It **conceptualises** They **conceptualise**

Conceptualise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am conceptualising** We **are conceptualising**
You **are conceptualising** You **are conceptualising**
He/She/It **is conceptualising** They **are conceptualising**

Conceptualise in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have conceptualised** We **have conceptualised**
You **have conceptualised** You **have conceptualised**
He/She/It **has conceptualised** They **have conceptualised**

Conceptualise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been conceptualising** We **have been conceptualising**
You **have been conceptualising** You **have been conceptualising**
He/She/It **has been conceptualising** They **have been conceptualising**

Conceptualise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **conceptualised** We **conceptualised**
You **conceptualised** You **conceptualised**
He/She/It **conceptualised** They **conceptualised**

Conceptualise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was conceptualising We were conceptualising
You were conceptualising You were conceptualising
He/She/It was conceptualising They were conceptualising

Conceptualise in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had conceptualised We had conceptualised
You had conceptualised You had conceptualised
He/She/It had conceptualised They had conceptualised

Conceptualise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been conceptualising We had been conceptualising
You had been conceptualising You had been conceptualising
He/She/It had been conceptualising They had been conceptualising

Conceptualise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will conceptualise We will conceptualise
You will conceptualise You will conceptualise
He/She/It will conceptualise They will conceptualise

Conceptualise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be conceptualising We will be conceptualising
You will be conceptualising You will be conceptualising
He/She/It will be conceptualising They will be conceptualising

Conceptualise in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have conceptualised

We will have conceptualised

You will have conceptualised

You will have conceptualised

He/She/It will have conceptualised **They will have conceptualised**

Conceptualise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been conceptualising

We will have been conceptualising

You will have been conceptualising

You will have been conceptualising

He/She/It will have been conceptualising **They will have been conceptualising**
