# **Conjugate Concern**

**Concern in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense** 



Singular Plural
I concern We concern
You concern You concern
He/She/It concerns They concern

## **Concern in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular Plural

I am concerning We are concerning
You are concerning You are concerning
He/She/It is concerning They are concerning

### **Concern in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular Plural

I have concerned We have concerned You have concerned He/She/It has concerned They have concerned

### **Concern in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I have been concerning
You have been concerning
He/She/It has been concerning
They have been concerning

## Concern in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I concerned We concerned
You concerned You concerned
He/She/It concerned They concerned

# Concern in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was concerning We were concerning
You were concerning You were concerning
He/She/It was concerning They were concerning

### **Concern in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular Plural

I had concerned We had concerned
You had concerned You had concerned
He/She/It had concerned They had concerned

### **Concern in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular** Plural

I had been concerning
You had been concerning
He/She/It had been concerning
They had been concerning

## **Concern in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular Plural

I will concern
You will concern
He/She/It will concern
They will concern

## **Concern in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular Plural

I will be concerning
You will be concerning
He/She/It will be concerning
They will be concerning

#### **Concern in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular Plural

I will have concerned We will have concerned You will have concerned He/She/It will have concerned They will have concerned

## **Concern in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular** Plural

I will have been concerning
You will have been concerning
He/She/It will have been concerning
They will have been concerning
