Concert in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I concert We concert
You concert You concert
He/She/It concerts They concert

Concert in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am concerting We are concerting
You are concerting
He/She/It is concerting They are concerting

Concert in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have concerted We have concerted You have concerted You have concerted He/She/It has concerted They have concerted

Concert in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been concerting
You have been concerting
He/She/It has been concerting
They have been concerting

Concert in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Concert in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was concerting
You were concerting
He/She/It was concerting They were concerting

Concert in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had concerted We had concerted You had concerted He/She/It had concerted They had concerted

Concert in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been concerting
You had been concerting
He/She/It had been concerting
They had been concerting

Concert in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will concert
You will concert
He/She/It will concert
They will concert

Concert in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be concerting
You will be concerting
He/She/It will be concerting
They will be concerting

Concert in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have concerted We will have concerted You will have concerted He/She/It will have concerted They will have concerted

Concert in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been concerting
You will have been concerting
He/She/It will have been concerting
They will have been concerting
