Infinitive	<b>to concertize</b>
Present Tense	<b>concertize / concertizes</b>
Past Tense	<b>concertized</b>
Present Participle	<b>concertizing</b>
Past Participle	<b>concertized</b>

## Conjugate Concertize

### Concertize in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>concertize</b>	We <b>concertize</b>
You <b>concertize</b>	You <b>concertize</b>
He/She/It <b>concertizes</b>	They <b>concertize</b>

**Concertize in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am concertizing</b>	We <b>are concertizing</b>
You <b>are concertizing</b>	You <b>are concertizing</b>
He/She/It <b>is concertizing</b>	They <b>are concertizing</b>

**Concertize in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have concertized</b>	We <b>have concertized</b>
You <b>have concertized</b>	You <b>have concertized</b>
He/She/It <b>has concertized</b>	They <b>have concertized</b>

**Concertize in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been concertizing</b>	We <b>have been concertizing</b>
You <b>have been concertizing</b>	You <b>have been concertizing</b>
He/She/It <b>has been concertizing</b>	They <b>have been concertizing</b>

**Concertize in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>concertized</b>	We <b>concertized</b>
You <b>concertized</b>	You <b>concertized</b>
He/She/It <b>concertized</b>	They <b>concertized</b>

**Concertize in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I was concertizing</b>	<b>We were concertizing</b>
<b>You were concertizing</b>	<b>You were concertizing</b>
<b>He/She/It was concertizing</b>	<b>They were concertizing</b>

**Concertize in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had concertized</b>	<b>We had concertized</b>
<b>You had concertized</b>	<b>You had concertized</b>
<b>He/She/It had concertized</b>	<b>They had concertized</b>

**Concertize in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had been concertizing</b>	<b>We had been concertizing</b>
<b>You had been concertizing</b>	<b>You had been concertizing</b>
<b>He/She/It had been concertizing</b>	<b>They had been concertizing</b>

**Concertize in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will concertize</b>	<b>We will concertize</b>
<b>You will concertize</b>	<b>You will concertize</b>
<b>He/She/It will concertize</b>	<b>They will concertize</b>

**Concertize in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will be concertizing</b>	<b>We will be concertizing</b>
<b>You will be concertizing</b>	<b>You will be concertizing</b>
<b>He/She/It will be concertizing</b>	<b>They will be concertizing</b>

**Concertize in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have concertized**

**We will have concertized**

**You will have concertized**

**You will have concertized**

**He/She/It will have concertized**

**They will have concertized**

**Concertize in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been concertizing**

**We will have been concertizing**

**You will have been concertizing**

**You will have been concertizing**

**He/She/It will have been concertizing**

**They will have been concertizing**
