Conclude in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I conclude We conclude
You conclude You conclude
He/She/It concludes They conclude

Conclude in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am concluding
You are concluding
He/She/It is concluding They are concluding

Conclude in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have concluded We have concluded You have concluded You have concluded He/She/It has concluded They have concluded

Conclude in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been concluding
You have been concluding
He/She/It has been concluding
They have been concluding

Conclude in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Conclude in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was concluding We were concluding
You were concluding You were concluding
He/She/It was concluding They were concluding

Conclude in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had concluded We had concluded You had concluded You had concluded He/She/It had concluded They had concluded

Conclude in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been concluding
You had been concluding
He/She/It had been concluding
They had been concluding

Conclude in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will conclude
You will conclude
He/She/It will conclude
They will conclude

Conclude in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be concluding
You will be concluding
He/She/It will be concluding
They will be concluding

Conclude in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have concluded
You will have concluded
He/She/It will have concluded
They will have concluded

Conclude in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been concluding
You will have been concluding
He/She/It will have been concluding
They will have been concluding
