Condition in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I am conditioning

We are conditioning

You are conditioning

You are conditioning

He/She/It is conditioning

They are conditioning

Condition in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I have conditioned

We have conditioned

You have conditioned

You have conditioned

He/She/It has conditioned

They have conditioned

Condition in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

I have been conditioning

We have been conditioning

You have been conditioning

You have been conditioning

He/She/It has been conditioning

They have been conditioning

Condition in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

| He/She/It will be conditioning | They will be conditioning |

Condition in Future Perfect Tense

I will have conditioned

We will have conditioned

You will have conditioned

You will have conditioned

He/She/It will have conditioned

They will have conditioned

Condition in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

I will have been conditioning

We will have been conditioning

You will have been conditioning

You will have been conditioning

He/She/It will have been conditioning

They will have been conditioning
