I **am conditioning**

We **are conditioning**

You **are conditioning**

You **are conditioning**

He/She/It **is conditioning** They **are conditioning**

I **have conditioned**

We **have conditioned**

You **have conditioned**

You **have conditioned**

He/She/It **has conditioned** They **have conditioned**

He/She/It had conditioned **They had conditioned**

We had been conditioning

You had been conditioning

He/She/It had been conditioning **They had been conditioning**

We will conditionate

You will conditionate

You will conditionate

He/She/It will conditionate **They will conditionate**

You will be conditioning

You will be conditioning

He/She/It will be conditioning **They will be conditioning**
